is a Non-governmental, not-for-profit organisation with an aim to inspire, support and empower young people. This is achieved through the three themes of promoting, education and training in healthier lifestyles and greater social cohesion. CONTEXT



The TC "EVS-Bigger, Better, Brighter" aims to enhance the quality of EVS projects through development of essential competences of support persons. It also provides up-to-date information to its participants on the opportunities given by the Erasmus+: Youth in Action Programme. The training course is designed for those who are directly involved in the work around the EVS volunteer (e.g. mentors and task-related support persons) on the hosting, sending and coordinating side. The support people play a crucial role in providing conditions for a quality voluntary service and creating opportunities for volunteer's learning in EVS.

The project is also an opportunity for reaching out to new partners for future cooperation, for exchanging EVS volunteers and spread our message around the European public sphere.



OBJECTIVES

- To get a better understanding of the concept of EVS as "learning service" and related quality aspects in EVS;
- To improve the ability for co-operation and working in international partnership;
- To reflect on the roles, responsibilities and challenges within the EVS projects;

- To raise awareness of the learning dimension in EVS and provide tools for learning support;
- To support the recognition of non-formal learning in EVS through the competent implementation of Youthpass;
- To provide up-to-date information about the new European programme for youth.

During the training course we will favor a common ground among participants to understand the concept of EVS. We will reflect on its values, reasons, interests and needs of all actors involved. We will support the process of understanding EVS as "learning service", linked with the concept of European citizenship. The learning dimension of EVS service: EVS is very much about learning – non-formal and informal. It is about acquiring new life experiences, but also gaining new competences – getting new knowledge, improving skills and developing attitudes.

We will go through the different stages of the learning process and you will get acquainted with the concept of Key Competences and Youthpass.






ACCOMMODATION



During the whole training course we will stay in a **Hostel** in Whitley Bay, which is a beautiful town located by the sea. All the rooms have 4/6/8 beds with communal shower facilities.





Address of the hostel is 25 South Parade, Whitley Bay, NE26 2RE.

→ 4 minutes walk from Metro Station! When you will be out of the Metro Station, go straight on Station Rd, which will become Esplanade Rd. Then TURN LEFT onto Linden Terrace (is a small pedestrian street). Walk until the end of it and then TURN RIGHT. After few meters, on your right, you will find our Hostel!
