

It is made up of a network of walking routes in SW Portugal, totaling 400 km to walk, along the most beautiful and best preserved coastline of Southern Europe. There are currently 200 partner companies, a team of 11 people working daily at the Association's headquarters, more than 150 volunteers and several public entities that are part of the broad partnership created around the project.

The Rota Vicentina is a network of walking routes in the Sw of Portugal, fully signalized, totaling 400 km to walk, along one of the most beautiful and well preserved coastal areas of southern Europe and formed by the Historical Path, Fishermen's Trail and several Circular Paths.

The Sw of Portugal are 110 km of wild coast and about 75 thousand hectares of protected area, inserted in the Natural Park of the Southwest Alentejo and Costa Vicentina, constituted by a varied set of habitats, some of them still little altered, where diverse species occur endemic plants and a large number of animal species, especially amphibians, birds and marine fauna. LOCAL CONTEXT

São Luís village, where the EVS activity occurs, is located in Odemira municipality, region of Southern Alentejo. Odemira is the largest municipality in Portugal, in what concerns the size of the territory, with a significant dispersion of the population. It is mainly rural, in particular in the interior part. It has a large coast by the Atlantic ocean, with many beached and an accentuated touristic activity in Summer.

São Luís is located 14km away from the sea and 17km away from the head of the municipality, Odemira. There is public transportation to Lisboa and to the Algarve (ca. 2 times a day) and to Odemira (ca. 3 times a day). São Luís has about 2000 inhabitants, one primary school, one pharmacy, elders' care, health centre, bank, one traditional market, bakery, a couple of mini markets and a lot of coffee shops and restaurants. It is a traditional community of Alentejo and the main economic activities involve agriculture, cattle, cork, forestry, small commerce and services. The local cultural context is dynamic, with a combination of traditional cultural and contemporary art, typical events throughout the year and an arts exhibition in Summer. Local population has mainly older people, as young people tend to move to the cities looking for opportunities of higher education and employment.

DESCRIPTION OF EVS PROJECT

This EVS position focuses on Environment and Sustainable communities, aiming at supporting the initiative of local citizens who are aware of current global environmental and social challenges and are active in their local community.

The EVS position will explore ecological lifestyles, implemented by different people and entities in the region of São Luís. It is suitable for young people wishing to explore alternative lifestyles and reflect about their own, while supporting the initiative of the local community. One volunteer will be hosted by GAIA Alentejo in São Luís, for 12 months, and will support the activities lead by different local work groups and associations. The focus of this EVS vacancy will be permaculture, local production and ecoconsumption, ecological lifestyles.

TASKS

The tasks of the volunteer will be built in a yearly calendar, according to seasonal needs, and the volunteer should be available to perform different kinds of tasks, responding to the necessities of the work groups.

 To document the work of local partners, concerning permaculture, local production and consumption and ecological lifestyles;

- To support the conception, preparation, implementation and documentation of one-off events (debates, films, presentation, workshops, walks...), held by GAIA Alentejo and local partners;

Meals are prepared by the volunteer, for which s/he receives a monthly fee.

The volunteer will have a bicycle for local transport in São Luís. Whenever necessary to travel outside of São Luís for EVS activities, GAIA assures the organisation of transports, free of charge to the volunteer.

Local context

São Luís village, where the EVS activity occurs, is located in Odemira municipality, region of Southern Alentejo. Odemira is the largest municipality in Portugal, in what concerns the size of the territory, with a significant dispersion of the population. It is mainly rural, in particular in the interior part. It has a large coast by the Atlantic ocean, with many beached and an accentuated touristic activity in Summer.

São Luís is located 14km away from the sea and 17km away from the head of the municipality, Odemira. There is public transportation to Lisboa and to the Algarve (ca. 2 times a day) and to Odemira (ca. 3 times a day). São Luís has about 2000 inhabitants, one primary school, one pharmacy, elders' care, health centre, bank, one traditional market, bakery, a couple of mini markets and a lot of coffee shops and restaurants. It is a traditional community of Alentejo and the main economic activities involve agriculture, cattle, cork, forestry, small commerce and services. The local cultural context is dynamic, with a combination of traditional cultural and contemporary art, typical events throughout the year and an arts exhibition in Summer. Local population has mainly older people, as young people tend to move to the cities looking for opportunities of higher education and employment.

DESCRIPTION OF EVS PROJECT

This EVS position consists in supporting "Ateneu do Catorze", the local initiative of artists in São Luís village. "Ateneu do Catorze" is a cultural and artistic space open since 2017, shared by people who develop creative activities in different areas and where cultural initiatives are promoted. LOCAL CONTEXT

We are part of a local network of organic farmers, eco-social projects in the region and we are in supportive exchange with our neighbours according to services and products.

We are located in Southern Portugal, in the Alentejo, in a landscape of soft rolling hills, cork oaks, olive trees, wandering sheep flocks, friendly people and a lot of sun. It is also a landscape which is affected by advancing desertification. There is not a lot of water available in the summer. This is why we have already started to build two lakes / water retention space.

LOCAL CONTEXT

A Copa da Vida has a renting contract for a 99ha property with a swiss foundation for 99 years. Our community is immersed in nature and we are located in the Alentejo region, in Vale Rodrigo, 5km south-west from Colos in the council of Odemira. From here it`s 35km to the atlantic ocean. There is public transport by bus available from up Colos. The next train station (Faro = 1,5 hrs and Lisbon = 2hrs) is called Funcheira and is in 20 km distance. Ecologically interesting in terms of diversity is, that a part of the land is the biggest remaining piece of forest in Alentejo. One of our intentions is to take land out of the cycle of speculation and to make it available long term to courageous and caring people and groups for progressive, innovative and particularly sustainable projects: independent of their financial situation. All different initiatives under the roof of A Copa da Vida share this common idea. For now there is a youth-project, a reforestation-project with tree-nursery, a permacultureproject, a horse-project and a seminar house.

DESCRIPTION OF EVS PROJECT

One volunteer will be hosted by A Copa da Vida ecological community for 12 months, near the village of Colos. Since, from our point of view, diversity and complexity is enriching our lives - and also because we have the capacities - we wish to share our knowledge as much as we can, in order to support the development and learning of volunteers. We want to do that on different levels: besides specific knowledge in different subjects we also offer the possibility for sharing and exchanging topics and experiences in group processes, by using NVC (non-violent communication). Odemira is the largest municipality in the country in terms of area of territory, with a pronounced population dispersion. It is a municipality of rural characteristics, especially in the interior areas where Santa Clara-a-Velha is. There is the Santa Clara dam , one of the largest dams in Europe. There is public transportation by train to Lisbon and the Algarve (3x a day). It currently has around 700 population and mostly elders with the level of compulsory school or no schooling. There is a primary school and a kindergarten, one pharmacy, Day Center and home for elderly support, recreational society, public health centre, withdraw money machine, 2 mini-markets, petrol pump, two cafes. In Santa Clara-a-Velha, the cultural context is poor but there is a

traditional music and dance group with regular activity (our partners) and free music classes once a week.
