The project

The short-term EVS project will involve 10 young people (50% of them less opportunities) from Europe who want to develop their skills and competences, get international experience as EVS volunteers, learn about different European countries and cultures. **Project is designed for volunteers who would like to spend active month of being involved in our Alliance workcamps.** If they have artistic skills they will have the opportunity to participate in the street theater (Donkey Caravan project) as well as other work such as fire prevention in Calpe and touristic promotion in Altea.

Work - main activities that EVS volunteers will be involved in:

Volunteers will support with their work activities such as:

During the summer season 2017 De Amicitia will organize around 30 workcamps/youth exchanges and other projects and will need the support of volunteers to:

- 1) <u>be a campleader</u>, leading an international workcamp. Open for a volunteer with previous experiences in workcamps.
- 2) <u>be supporter of a workcamp:</u> supporting the campleader or promoting any of the campaigns in which De Amicitia is involved. Open mainly for a volunteer with low or no experience in workcamps.
- 3) be a member of Donkey Caravan: Participating and leading a workcamp.
- 4) <u>support other local projects</u> such as fire control in Calpe or touristic promotion in Altea

To support or lead workcamps they will start participating in a workcamp as normal volunteers **or** get a training immersed in our activities, getting to know the way we work and prepare themselves for their project, participating in practical and theoretical training. We have a plan of individual training of the volunteers for their personal development through which they can enjoy further benefits of the unique international volunteering experience that EVS is offering.





About Altea/Calpe

Altea is a town and municipality located in the province of Alicante, Spain, north of Benidorm on the section of Mediterranean Coast called the Costa Blanca. The town is located in the seaside and offers possibilities of riding bicycles, take a sunbath on the beach, climb the mountains, have a hike to the lighthouse and other activities during your free time. Calpe, a nearby town with long history and deeply-rooted traditions, is also one of the main tourist destinations on the Costa Blanca. The Marina, the promenade and eleven kilometers of coastline, marked by cliffs, beaches and coves, are some of the many attractions.

Accommodation

Accommodation will be in a refuge, in a basically equipped summer house in Altea, close to the beach and city center or in a flat rented for volunteers in Altea/Calpe. Volunteers will buy the food in a special shop using the tickets from the town hall and cook for themselves. During workcamps food and accommodation is provided with project.

Profile of the volunteers we are looking for:

- willing to be actively involved in the activities of the project,
- motivated to learn, to adapt, to propose ideas, take iniciatives, open-minded and eager to discover other cultures. Motivated to develop personal skills, abilities and attitudes like communication, working in a team, conflict management, negotiation and decision making, perseverance, etc.,
- basic knowledge of Spanish, English and a driving licence would be welcome,
- open also for volunteers with less opprortunities people.

Financial conditions

EVS allowance given by De Amicitia to the volunteer during the project or by bank transfer = 105€ per month.

Travel reimbursement: 100% travel expenses till a limit determined by Erasmus Plus Conditions

Sending organizations support: SO will get up to 10 % EU grant as long as they send suitable candidates able to run projects according to agreement and conditions.
