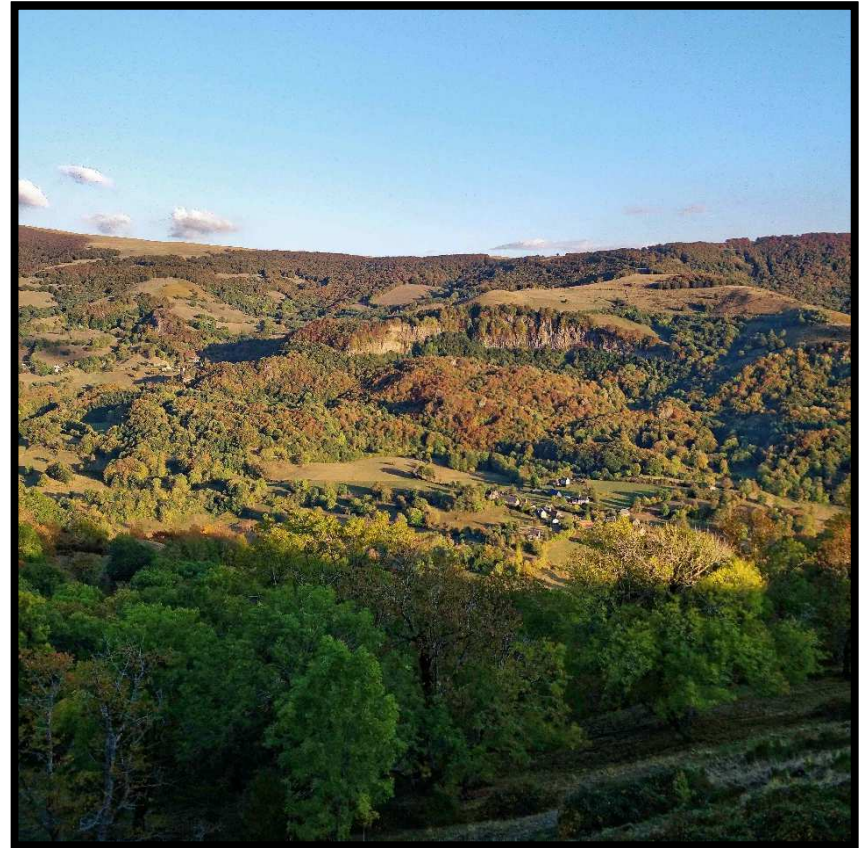

This presentation completes the invitation (see below) and specifies the content and programme of the first IPW planned in 2019.

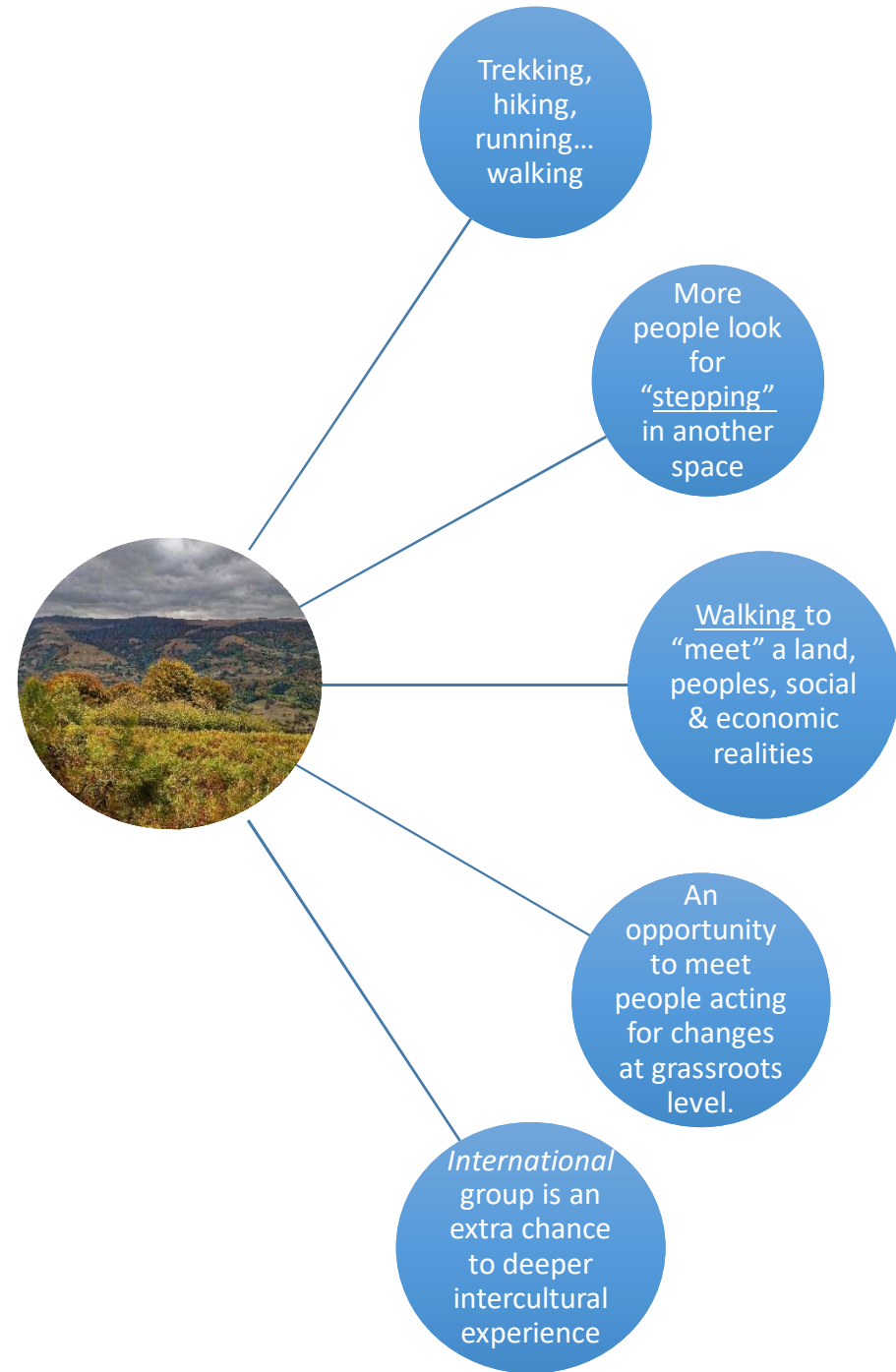

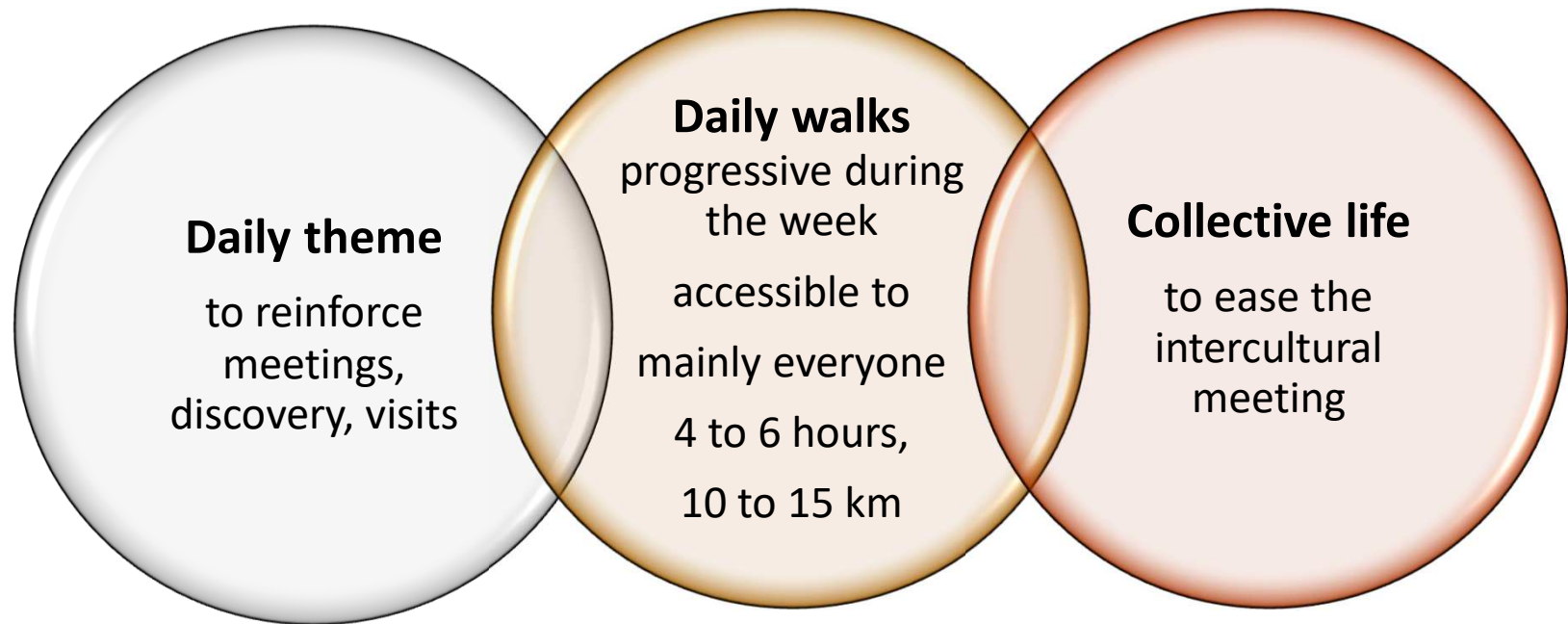


International Peace Walks aims to develop intercultural walks **worldwide**, an active practice for tolerance, **Peace** and sustainable development.

IPW is walking together and *meeting* a land!



Every IPW is build on the following organisational tryptic:



We plan to **experiment** the first *International Peace Walks* next Spring 2019 with two walks.

We **invite you** to join this **pilot phase**:

- Sending participant
- Participating yourself 😊
- Organising IPW in your country
- Designing future development ...



IPW 1, 23-27/04/2019,
self-managed group,
15-20 places,
140 € per person
+ *common pot* for food,
100 € minimum per
person.



IPW 2, 20-24/05/2019,
full board group,
15-20 places,
345 € per person.

Each group is open to 15 participants (mini 10 - max 20), from any background.

Gradually, the international dimension will be stronger (Europe & other regions),

The group is supported by local volunteers, and in case, by specialists.

In case of self managed group, organisation will be adapted for meal preparation.

A *common-pot* will be open by the group. We recommend individual contributions of 100 € minimum (for 5 days). The group will decide to raise it. The host organisation will ease the use of the kitchen, washing up equipment ...

An IPW is organised by a
local partner

(organisation, group, guide, community).

This team organise the walks, the stay and the meeting programme.

They facilitate the group life and lead activities.

They send preparation material and information.

They decide about the financial conditions and collect the *participation fees*.



IPW 2019

All application will be managed directly by the host “Ferme de Trielle”

NO application fees for this first try.

Only participation fees covering direct costs.



This local NGO is involved in cultural and rural Development.

They organised *international workcamps* and *inclusion work-project* for years with Etudes et Chantiers (Anec /Unarec).

This venue hosted a CCIVS EC meeting in 1992, named *Thiezac* in the archives. 😊

- Global event's organisation and international networks relations.

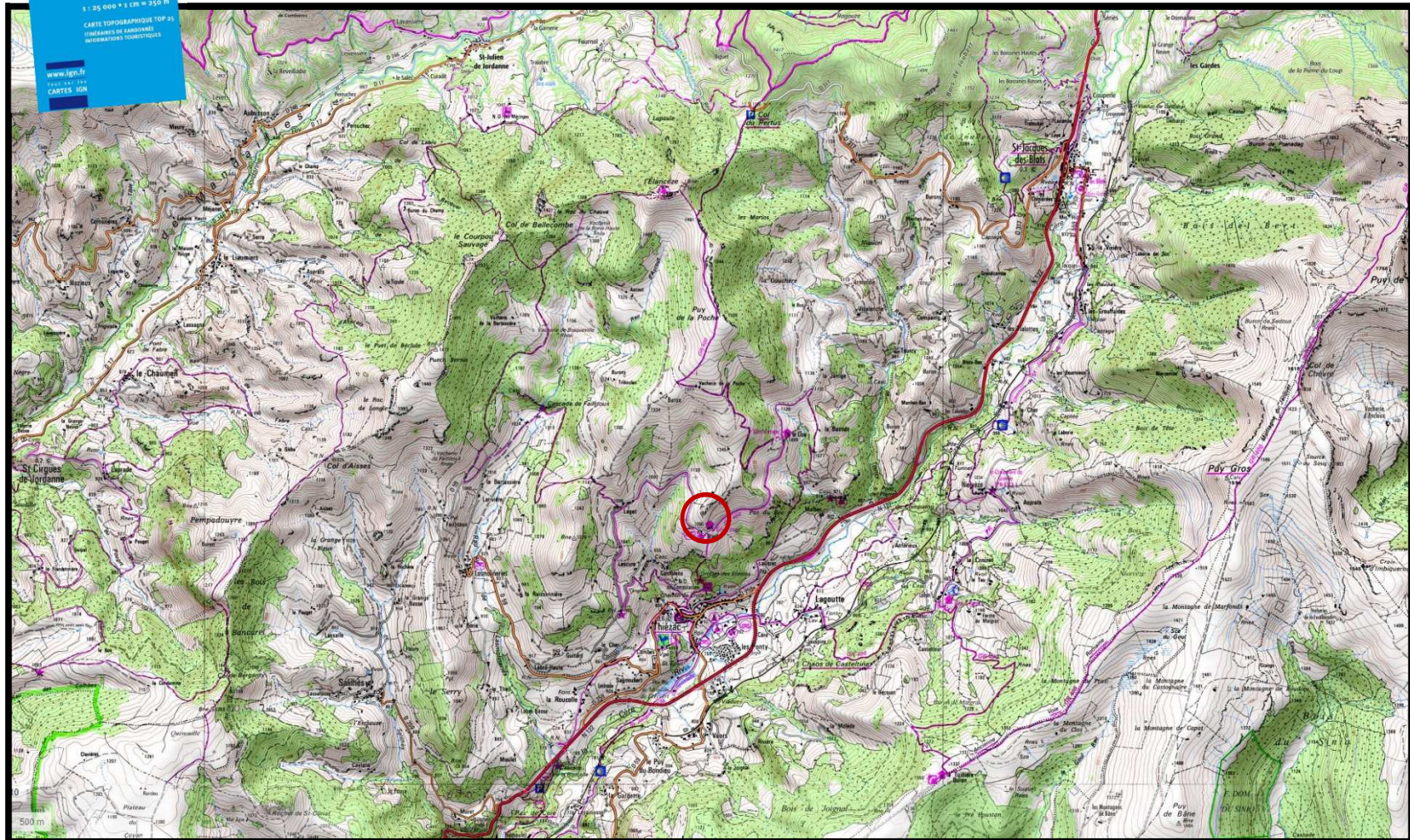
