- Provides computer support to seniors to break isolation

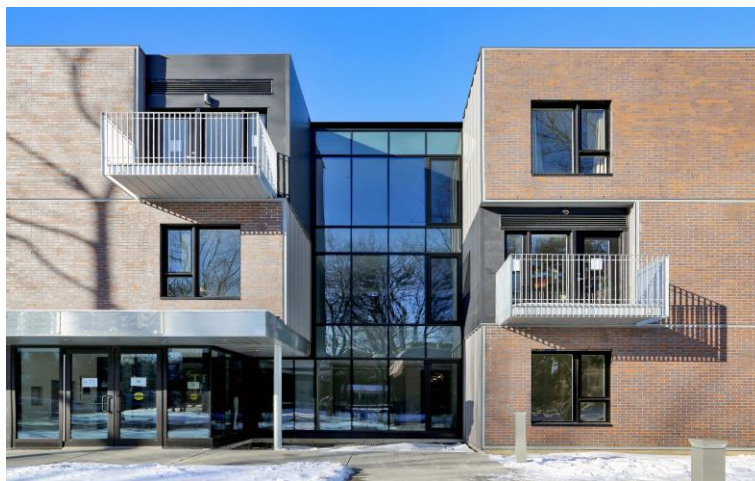
HOSTING PARTNER
