# Call for participants for international youth encounter Facing Discrimination and Practices to Promote Inclusion in Bucharest, Romania, on 12-18 March 2020

The meeting is a part of the project "City. Place for Youth. Space for Dialogue", wich offers opportunities for young people from Estonia, Germany, and Romania:



- to meet together;
- to learn about the life of their peers in different corners of Europe;
- to discuss about participation, inclusion, dialogue, and democracy;
- to share and develop their ideas and initiatives for their local communities;
- to bring their opinions to decision-makers.

The aim of the meeting in Bucharest is to raise awareness on diversity, to learn about different forms of exclusion and discrimination and to get to know good practices of working for an inclusive society.

# Methodology

**Get involved!** The program will be implemented using methods of non-formal education that promote interaction and reflection. The participants will be invited to take part in discussions, simulation games, meetings and visits, opinion sharing and other interactive methods. Working individually, in small groups and in plenary (all together) will be alternated.

The topic will be explored not only on social but also on a personal level. It's important that the participants are ready to reflect on their experience, think critically about their own attitudes towards values and activity and share their thoughts and feelings with the group.

The meeting includes exploring interesting public spaces and local initiatives, meetings with activists and decision-makers (representatives of public authorities/ politicians).

# We invite to participate young people 16-24 years old (with possible exceptions) who:

- are either involved in any groups, organizations or initiatives on local levels,
- or have the desire to be involved in any initiatives for changing their communities,
