INVOLVEMENT OF THE VOLUNTEER:

- Taking part in various summer activities of the Centers (summer camps, bike tours);
- Propose, Implement and run their own initiatives addressed to the young and their involvement (sport, excursion, games, etc.);

Volunteer's Profile

"Tbilisi Youth Centre Union" doesn't require any particular qualifications from its potential candidates. All the necessary training is provided to the volunteers by the hosting organisation after coming to the place of the service. This way anyone is able to take part in the project regardless of their age, gender, religion, education and social background. However, we look for a motivated candidate who is willing to take part in a great diversity of activities and to develop a large panel of skills. Apart from this, we will look for a volunteer who will be very motivated and ready to get to know the cultural and social aspects of the country better.

The potential volunteer is:

- between 18 and 30 years old;
- Motivated to learn and to come up with their own ideas and suggestions for solutions;
- Has at least intermediate level of english (b1 and up)
- Has interest in facilitation and organisation of workshops and campaigns;
- Punctual and reliable team player;
- Eager to learn and share knowledge;
- Respectful of the way others are;
- Willing to understand others' point of view.

WHERE WE ARE AND HOW WE WORK:

OUR ADDRESS IS MARJANISHVILI 24,TBILISI. IT IS 5 MINUTES WALK FROM THE STATION MARJANISHVILI AND YOU CAN GET HERE BY SUBWAY FROM YOUR FLAT, OR BY BUS NO 59 AND 91.

THE OFFICE IS RUN ON EVERYDAY BASIS, FROM 11.00-18.00, WORKING HOURS OF THE VOLUNTEERS ARE FLEXIBLE.

THERE CAN BE SOMETIMES WORK DURING WEEKENDS (TRAINING, SEMINARS, INFORMATIONAL MEETING) WITH POSSIBLE TAKING DAYS OFF AFTER. VOLUNTEERS WILL HAVE OWN SPACE AT THE OFFICE. PLEASE HAVE A LAPTOP IN CASE OF REMOTE WORK.

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

THE PROJECT IS FOR 10-MONTHS, STARTING IN SPRING (IDEALLY DURING MARCH-APRIL 2021). THE EXACT STARTING DATE IS AGREED WITH THE VOLUNTEER.

VOLUNTEER WILL BE ACCOMMODATED IN A SHARED FLAT DURING THE VOLUNTEERING ACTIVITY. ACCOMMODATION IS FULLY COVERED AND FREE OF CHARGE FOR THE VOLUNTEER. VOLUNTEERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEANING AND PRESERVING THEIR ACCOMMODATION.

THE TRAVEL BUDGET FOR THE ROUND TRIP ESTONIA-GEORGIA-ESTONIA IS 360 EURO. LOCAL TRANSPORT IN THE CITY AND BETWEEN FACILITIES WILL BE PROVIDED BY HOSTING ORGANISATION.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR THE VOLUNTEER:

POCKET MONEY | 3 EUR/ PER DAY (CA 90 EUR/PER MONTH) FOOD ALLOWANCE | 3.30 EUR/ PER DAY (CA 99 EUR/PER MONTH) LOCAL TRANSPORT SUPPORT | 0.50 EUR/ PER DAY (CA 15 EUR/PER MONTH)

THE VOLUNTEER IS ENROLLED TO CIGNA INSURANCE, WHICH COVERS ALL THE NEEDS FOR THE WHOLE DURATION OF THE PROJECT AND EVEN AFTER THAT (FOR A FEW MONTHS). THE REGISTRATION TO THE INSURANCE IS MADE BY THE SUPPORTING ORGANIZATION.

GEORGIAN LANGUAGE LESSONS

DURATION OF ONE LESSON IS 1H-1,5H. 2-3 TIMES IN A WEEK. VOLUNTEER RECEIVES LANGUAGE TRAINING (FORMAL AND NON-FORMAL) THROUGHOUT THE STAY AND IT'S ARRANGED BY THE HOSTING ORGANISATION. WE WILL PROVIDE THE VOLUNTEERS WITH ALL THE NECESSARY COURSES AND TRAININGS NEEDED.

MENTORSHIP

The volunteer will have a mentor, who will help and support during the ESC project. Mentor will be an experienced person who has a volunteering background, in order to better communicate and understand volunteers' problems.

Volunteer will have a regular communication with mentor who will help during the adaptation and support period. A mentor will have regular meetings with a volunteer, once a week, in case of need 2 or 3 times a week.

 Tbilisi is a city of contrasts: a meeting point between eastern and western civilisations for centuries, it remains one today. Built along the riverbank of the Kura (Mtkvari, in Georgian) and surrounded by hills, Tbilisi has been settled since before the 4th century, but boasts a skyscape that includes twenty - first century architecture. Tbilisi can be international. cosmopolitan and sophisticated, yet it is essentially and distinctly Georgian and retains a close focus on local tradition and culture. It can feel as cosy as a small town, and just as inviting and adventurous as a city.

- Our currency is called Lari (GEL) and the small ones are Tetri
- The free city Wi-fi "Tbilisi loves you" unfortunately doesn't love you most of the time. It usually works only in metro stations and on Liberty Square.
- You don't need to leave a tips, they are included in the bills as 10-15% fee.
- Shops open at ten, food markets around nine. A lot of grocery stores are open 24/24.
- Museums and galleries usually closed on Mondays.
- For charging transport cards, buying trains tickets, and charging your phone balance for Georgian SIM cards use a machines called paybox, which closely resembles a free-standing ATM and on almost every corner. Be careful-they don't give a change!
