TRAVELLING

- Your traveling costs are fully covered **up to 250 euro** for Spain, Italy, Greece, Netherlands, Poland, Romania, Germany, The Republic of North Macedonia, Malta Estonia, **335 euros** for Portugal and **155 euros** for Austria.
- Your travel costs **are covered** from your home town to Zagreb, capital of Croatia. We reduced 25 euros from each participant because we will organize transport from Zagreb to the venue where the project will take place.
- Just be sure to **SAVE ALL THE TICKETS, BOARDING PASSES.** We will collect them on the first day. If you lose any of the tickets or boarding passes, we won't be able to reimburse you for those tickets.

ACCOMODATION & FOOD

- Accomodation is fully covered by the project. There are pillow cases and bed linens. There are free for you to use them, you don't have to bring anything.
- Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be provided by the venue. During your

free days you will receive food money in the amount of 40€ (7€ per day)

INSURANCE

- It is mandatory for all the participants to make their own EHIC card (European health insurance card, which is free. Bring it to the project. Besides the EHIC card, all the participants will have private insurance by CIGNA. The registration to the insurance is made by the Sending organization.
- Covid test the projects covers up to 100 euros per participant (if the covid test will be needed to enter the country)

POCKET MONEY

• You will get 115 euros for 23 days (21 activity days + 2 travel days) based on the European Solidarity Corps guide (5 euro per day).
