The workcamp is coordinated by an experienced volunteer, who is not the boss of the camp: we ask the camp-coordinators to ease the first days of the camp and to involve the volunteers in being responsible for the project, using consensus methodology. The camp-coordinator is not at all responsible for volunteers' fun and the best camp has a camp-coordinator who slightly goes back to the status of normal volunteer.....So, prepare to take responsibilities!

WORKCAMP SHORT DESCRIPTIONS

**LUNAR01 “Cleaning the coast of Giglio”, Isola del Giglio (Tuscany), 10/05/2022-21/05/2022
ENVI/MANU VOL: 12 AGE: 18+**

SUMMARY : Support local community in the care, maintenance and cleaning of the paths on the Mediterranean coast. **#TeamSpirit, #lunarcamp**

PARTNER : The workcamp is organized by Proloco, a cultural organization, that has among its institutional tasks the valorization of the natural, cultural and historical resources of Giglio island, as well as the realization of initiatives of touristic interest. The Pro.Loco promotes the workcamp in collaboration with the municipality and a network of associations in the area: Lega Navale, Giglio Ambiente and a Consortium of local waste companies, which work together every year to clean the island's coastline.

PROJECT : The Mediterranean Sea, although constituting less than 1% of the planet's water surface, is the sixth area of accumulation of waste in the world. Plus, during winter storms, waves dump an important amount of waste, mainly plastic. And an Island like ours, which lives mainly on tourism, the care and maintenance of its natural resources is the first ticket to see, as well as the minimum requirement to allow our visitors to live the fantastic experience they deserve. The objective of this project is to reduce the waste on the island's coast which would benefit the environment and tourism. By joining this workcamp you will contribute to the Sustainable Development Goals: **Climate Action-SDG13; Life below water-SDG14**

WORK : Volunteers will be asked to collect wastes along the coastline of the island during the project. The activities will be concentrated mainly in the morning hours. The volunteers, together with local groups, will carry out various activities: cleaning the beaches, collecting plastic material (bottles, polystyrene boxes, corks, abandoned fishing tools) for disposal. Volunteers will be accompanied to the places of collection of waste either by car, or on foot along the paths of trekking, or by sea with boats, while the waste will always be collected and brought to the dump by sea by specialized personnel. Please, be prepared for a physically demanding work.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD : Volunteers will be hosted in a flat with shared rooms. All supplies will be guaranteed, 3 bathrooms/showers, wi-fi connection, use of washing machine and kitchen. The volunteers will take care of the common areas and prepare meals. Vegetarian food is available.

LOCATION AND LEISURE : The island of Giglio is part of the Tuscan Archipelago National Park and the "Cetacean Sanctuary" protected area. The Island of Giglio, situated opposite Monte Argentario, covers an area of 21 square kilometers, is the second largest island in the Tuscan Archipelago and is renowned for its natural beauty: the crystal-clear emerald sea, with its rich and fishy seabed, frames an area that is still 90% wild. In addition to its natural heritage of beaches and coastline, the island has two towns, Giglio Castello, a charming medieval village that stands on the heights of the island, and Giglio Porto, the island's only port, small and picturesque, with multicolored houses and a clear sea.

Isola del Giglio has a resident community of about 1000 people, mainly engaged in tourist activities, strongly linked to their territory and always used to dealing with new visitors. <https://www.giglioinfo.it/en/>

TERMINAL: The nearest airport is Leonardo da Vinci in Rome Fiumicino, the railway station is Orbetello Scalo. Giglio Island can be reached by ferry from Porto Santo Stefano (1 hour). It takes 4 hours to reach the island of Giglio from Rome Fiumicino airport.

**LUNAR02 “Carignano Summer Camp”, Carignano (Turin), 19/06/2022-03/07/2022 KIDS/MANU VOL: 8
AGE: 18+**

SUMMARY : Support the summer camp of the village. **#kids #Interculturalism #Lunarcamp**

PARTNER : The camp is organized by Lunaria in collaboration with “Giovani insieme”. The association is composed of young people for young people founded in October 1998 in Carignano with the aim of

protecting, promoting and enhancing artistic, historical and architectural heritage, nature and the environment, by proposing summer work camps for young volunteers from all over Europe.

PROJECT : The workcamps in Carignano were started to restore some rooms in a building in the historical center of the town. Through this project volunteers have the opportunity to recover Carignano's architectural heritage and enjoy the environment whilst meeting young people from all over the world. Moreover "Giovani insieme" organizes different local events such as summer camps for local children, cultural exhibitions, etc. By joining this workcamp you will contribute to the Sustainable Development Goal: **Climate Action-SDG13**

WORK : Volunteers will work with children (from 6 to 13 years old) in the summer camp of the village. For an amazing experience of exchange, they could talk about their countries and also teach the children typical songs or dances. There will also be some manual and maintenance work to be done on the playground or the church. Every week the volunteers will go to two retirement homes to present their countries. The volunteers will meet an association that runs a project of taking care of refugees, in this way they can really see how that emergency is managed in Italy. Some Carignano's families will host the volunteers for a dinner in the house to share culture and way of life.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD : Volunteers will be hosted in a building with beds, communal bathrooms with 2 showers and hot water and a kitchen. Bedrooms are provided with 4 to 6 beds per room. The volunteers are responsible for the cleaning and cooking. Food is provided by the host organization. Volunteers must be equipped with a sleeping bag (or sheets), pillowcase and towels.

LOCATION AND LEISURE : The town of Carignano (8700 inhabitants) is situated on the left bank of the river Po approximately 20 Km from Torino and within the Regional Parco Fluviale (park of the river). Its center is of typical "piemontese" style, characterized by an ancient core with medieval archways and a baroque cathedral. The town's surroundings offer sites of architectural and naturalistic interest, it is also possible to reach Turin easily, as there are frequent coaches to the city. During the free time there are many exciting things to do such as visit the open market of Carignano and take part in some local events. On the weekends it will be possible for the group to organize a visit to Turin (there is a bus to and from Turin), visiting the Egyptian museum, the cinema museum, MAO museum of oriental art, the Holy Shroud etc. The costs of the FREE TIMES activities are not covered by the project.

TERMINAL: Nearest Airport Turin; Turin railway station; MEETING POINT in CARIGNANO bus station, It takes approximately 2/3 hours to reach the bus station from Turin airport.

LUNARESC03 "New Spaces for New Ideas", Roma, 20/06/2022-05/07/2022 RENO/CONS/SOCI VOLS: 12 AGE: 18-30

SUMMARY : Regenerate and rebuild an old school to create a "participative gym" for body, imagination to promote active citizenship and solidarity. **#community #solidarity #inclusion #lunarcamp #ESCinTeam**

PARTNER : The association ANITA (Association New Ideas for an Open Territory at Garibaldi School), composed of families and people from the area active in the "Open Schools" program, is committed to enhancing a public school as a "Common Good". Since 2013 they are committed to restore spaces of the school previously unused as the garden, the former janitor's house and the huge basement.

PROJECT : The aim is to return these restored spaces to the school itself and to the territory, with the creation of an educational and community garden, a historical archive, a "participative gym", that is for the body, for the imagination and to promote active citizenship and solidarity. The camp will contribute to the creation of a creative and inclusive gym (also accessible to people with disabilities) in the basement of the school. The recovered spaces will be used to carry out activities of socialization, inclusion, creativity and movement and will promote the values of solidarity, human rights, differences, women's rights, education for peace and freedom. Specifically ANITA wants to redevelop 12 spaces (not all of them this summer!), each dedicated to two athletes (one male and one female) who had to overcome socio-cultural barriers in order to play sports and whose story will be illustrated with panels or murals and summarized with the initials of the athletes who can inspire and encourage. By joining this workcamp you will contribute to the Sustainable Development Goals: **Reduce inequality -SDG10**

WORK : Volunteers will work approximately 6/7 hours per day with the contribution of the local community, families, children (age 6-12) and local teenagers (age 13-18). Work will be focused on:

- Renovation of the basement of the school: plastering, painting and making simple murals on the walls. Construction of climbing walls for the gym dedicated to this, with preparation work of the walls, carpentry and minor electrical maintenance;
- Care of the didactic garden: watering and keeping the spaces clean, creating a compost bin, an earthworm tank, signage in Italian and English, fixing a little wall, renovating doors and windows;
- Digitization of the school's historical archive, i.e. the class registers from the fascist period and the war, a very useful material to propose to the school children to do research on the discrimination perpetrated by fascism and the difficulties faced during the war;
- Artistic and bricolage activities: we will also try to give space to reuse activities (such as the creation of benches and sensory boards) and artistic activities (such as the creation of murals and a short video to let the school children know what has been done by the volunteer camp).

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD : Volunteers will be accommodated in the school itself, in the "House of the Thousand" (former janitor's house), which has all facilities (rooms, toilets, showers) and a kitchen. Volunteers can use the garden of the school to eat outdoors. Accommodation is very basic. Food can be prepared by volunteers themselves. Volunteers will take care of the common space and respect the place.

LOCATION AND LEISURE : Rome, near Piazza San Giovanni, 3 minutes walk from the metro station "Re di Roma" or "Ponte Lungo" (metro A) and 40 minutes walk from the Colosseum. We foresee that the volunteers will be able to make at least one full day excursion in Rome.

TERMINAL: The nearest terminal is Fiumicino and Ciampino Airport.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: This project is supported by the European Solidarity Corps. Food and accommodation are covered by the European Union. Transportation costs will be refunded according to the distance band rules of the programme. No fees are required. The workcamps are open for international volunteers (coming from EU ESC countries projects).

LUNAR04 "Together in the forest", Valgreghentino (Lecco), 01/07/2022-11/07/2022 ENVI/MANU VOLS: 10 AGE: 16-17 EXTRA FEE:200€

SUMMARY : Join us in the forest, to renovate and improve natural areas, challenge yourself in nature, bring life to an abandoned wood and make it accessible for the local community. Enjoy this beautiful place practicing outdoor activities! **#Citizenship #TEEN #Games #Environment #Lunarcamp**

PARTNER : The workcamp is organized by Liberi Sogni, a small non-profit organization that organizes, since 2006, social, cultural and environmental projects in the districts of Lecco, Bergamo and Monza e Brianza, in the region Lombardy. Liberi Sogni always considered the intercultural topic very important. Many people that work in the cooperative experimented directly with how important it is to promote solidarity and attention towards cultures, especially among young people. By joining this workcamp you will contribute to the Sustainable Development Goals: **LifeOnLand-SDG15** and **ClimateAction-SDG13**.

PROJECT : The cooperative is involved in promoting environmental protection, presenting alternative and sustainable ways of life through workshops in the schools, green days, weekends into nature and "Environmental Creative Camps" to preserve old woods and increase the value of our territory. Since 2014 Liberi Sogni has been involved in a project called "Crazy-resilience, to go back to nature to grow the future". Since the year 2021 a new project has begun, Liberi Sogni bought a rural structure named "Cascina Rapello" with a 9 hectare terrain, 3 hectares of agricultural fields and 6 of chestnut forest. In this place the coop is creating a place where to experiment and try new lifestyles and new ways to produce food, taking care of the soil and projecting the spaces in harmony with the surroundings. Cascina Rapello is an inclusive place where everyone can take action, schools, organized groups, families, children and everyone can take part in this new adventure. International volunteers will be in the care of a rural structure and a wood in a place useful and pleasant for the local community and living the experience of working in a non conventional farm. The main aims of the project are environmental education, sustainability of the food chain and awareness through the active engagement of young people in an international and natural environment. Through the experience in the woods and the social farm, we would like to achieve personal

development, increase active citizenship in society, improve language competences, raise participants' awareness and understanding of other cultures and countries.

WORK : There will be two different work experiences: in the first, for four days, the volunteers will make base in Cascina Rapello, living the international experience of working in a rural social farm, growing the vegetable garden and other cultivations, taking care of the structures as well as taking care of our 4 donkeys; in the second, for seven days they a group of italian volunteers will join the experience and both group will work to protect the forest and the environment.

The work will be mainly in the morning, about 4 hours per day with three types of activities:

- Arrangement of the camp, taking care of the vegetable garden and other cultivations, taking care of the donkeys and the water tanks.
- Work in the wood: building tables with wood materials (the tables will be used to create in the wood a relax-area for the local people) and fixing or building footpaths.
- Cooking to prepare lunch with organic food coming from the nearby area
- Support for the creation of artistic and environmental laboratories

In the afternoon the participants will take part in special workshops in local small farms, workshops with local associations for taking care of the paths and small rivers.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD : The participants will sleep in tents of 4 people. The tents will be provided, but the volunteers will have to bring their camping mattress and sleeping bag. The tents will be divided into girls and boys tents. Participants must carry their belongings in a backpack, as they will arrive at camp on foot. Electricity and hot water will be provided by photovoltaic and solar panels. The toilet is 2 compost toilets, made of wood. The food will be prepared by the volunteers, who will eat together in a big tent. Most of the food will come from local farms from the fair trade.

Drinking water will be taken from the local fountain. The food will be prepared by the participants, who will eat together in a big tent. Most of the food will come from local farms from the fair trade market. There won't be an internet connection and the use of electricity will be very few since we use photovoltaic panels. Participants can bring typical food of their countries to share but alcohol is not allowed in the camp.

LOCATION AND LEISURE : From the 1st until the 4th of July international volunteers will be hosted in Cascina Rapello sited in Aizurro (LC), after they will move with the group of italian volunteers to the campsite; a wood located in a local park called "Parco del Monte di Brianza" (Valgrehentino-LC), in the north of Italy. In the past, this area was used for agriculture, but now most of it is abandoned: we can see abandoned buildings, woods, and fields. Invasive plants are growing, avoiding the growth of the local ones. To reach the CRAZY-WOOD there's a gravel road or a footpath. (See the place in this map: <https://goo.gl/maps/YxwVEVgUnPE2>) The closest village is Aizurro, a very little village with around 180 inhabitants. The closest place with facilities like shops, train stations or other services is the village of Airuno. During the day there is some time for games and activities (for example tree-climbing, excursions, land art). Some evenings will be organized with "cultural nights", where one or more countries organize a dinner with the typical food and games and /or workshops to show their own culture. The rest of the evenings there will be moments at the fireplace, free evenings or some games in the darkness.

TERMINAL: Nearest airport Milan, nearest train station Calolziocorte-Olginate. It takes approximately 2/3 hours Calolziocorte-Olginate from Milan airport.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Extra fee of 200€ to be paid to Liberi Sogni Association one month before the start of the camp. A proof of payment will be required by the 1st of June

LUNAR05 "I Volunteer I", Carignano (Turin), 03/07/2022-16/07/2022 ENVI/MANU/DISA VOLS: 8 AGE: 18+

SUMMARY : Support the city forest, planted by the locals 30 years ago to make it more usable by the community. **#bamboo #envi #Lunarcamp**

PARTNER : The camp is organized by Lunaria in collaboration with "Giovani insieme". The association is composed of young people for young people founded in October 1998 in Carignano with the aim of protecting, promoting and enhancing artistic, historical and architectural heritage, nature and the environment, by proposing summer work camps for young volunteers from all over Europe.

PROJECT : The workcamps in Carignano were started to restore some rooms in a building in the historical center of the town. Through this project volunteers have the opportunity to recover Carignano's architectural heritage and enjoy the environment whilst meeting young people from all over the world. Moreover "Giovani insieme" organizes different local events such as summer camps for local children, cultural exhibitions, etc. By joining this workcamp you will contribute to the Sustainable Development Goals: **LifeOnLand-SDG15** and **ClimateAction-SDG13**.

WORK : The aim of the project is to restore Villa Bona, a wonderful historical villa of the 18th century and the surrounding park to make it usable for public events, concerts, exhibitions etc.

Volunteers will work to implement the city forest, planted by the locals 30 years ago to make it more usable by the community. The work will be close to the river Po in a protected area called "Parco fluviale del Po" where the volunteers will also cut bamboo to protect the endemic vegetation and clean paths and weeds; painting some benches in public gardens in the village and also fences. The work inside the Villa Bona will be scratching wooden doors and painting them. There could also be cleaning work in some bell towers and churches. The volunteers will be also involved in the creation of a big mural "I VOLUNTEER" representing the workcamps season in Villa Bona 2022. Together with the international volunteers there will be a group of local youngsters involved in the same activities. Local volunteers will be Teenagers (14-17) and volunteers from an association called AU.DI.DO (autonomy for disabled people). Every week the volunteers will go to two retirement homes to present their countries. The volunteers will also meet an association that runs a project of taking care of refugees, in this way they can really see how that emergency is managed in Italy. Some Carignano's families will host the volunteers for a dinner in the house to share culture and way of life. The central idea of the workcamp is to exchange traditions and explore other cultures so please be ready to present something typical of your country (a dance, a song, a game, a typical dish, a custom etc.)

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD : The participants will sleep in a building with beds, communal bathrooms with 2 showers and hot water and a kitchen. Bedrooms are provided with 4 to 6 beds per room. The volunteers are responsible for the cleaning and cooking. Food is provided by the host organization. Volunteers must be equipped with a sleeping bag (or sheets), pillowcase and towels.

LUNARESC06 "Teatri Riflessi Festival", Zafferana Etnea, 04/07/2022-19/07/2022 CULT/FEST/ART VOLS: 12 AGE: 18-30

SUMMARY : Join us for promoting the short play format, encouraging a discussion on dramaturgy, and enhancing the immediacy of contemporary art languages. **#IterCulture #art #Lunarcamp #ESCinTeam**

PARTNER : IterCulture is a non-profit organization that offers services in the organization, promotion and management of cultural projects and performances. IterCulture was founded in 2009, aiming at managing its main project, Teatri Riflessi. At its 7th edition, Teatri Riflessi | International Short play Festival is a competition for professional and emerging artists and companies. Artists are asked to submit a short play, no matter the genre: drama, poetry, or dance.

PROJECT : Since its first edition in 2009, the festival, Teatri Riflessi, has been promoting the short play format, encouraging a discussion on dramaturgy, and enhancing the immediacy of contemporary art languages. The project also stimulates a reflection on the landscape, connecting the stage to the

representation of the artistic, cultural, and social territory in unconventional spaces. With a combination of culture and entertainment, the festival wants to mesmerize a heterogeneous audience, especially those who do not usually go to the theater. Teatri Riflessi is meant to lift the curtain on the flowering of artistic urges, promoting the exchange of ideas, practices, and models and offering professional and emerging artists an unusual stage to connect tradition and innovation. By joining this workcamp you will contribute to the Sustainable Development Goals: **Reduce inequality -SDG10**

WORK : Volunteers will be asked to help support the organization and unfolding of the festival. Members of the workcamp are asked to work around 6 hours a day during the first week to get to know the event and plan in detail with IterCulture the organization and setting up of the short play competition and the pop-up market. The second week will require up to 8 hours of work a day, from 11 to 16 July to allow the setting up of the area and the realization of some activities linked with the event (roundtables, laboratories, exhibitions), and the welcoming of artists and the audience.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD : Volunteers will be accommodated in the school gym of Zafferana Etnea where they can use the toilets and showers and a space will be used to cook, so volunteers can have their meals together, but they will also be invited to join the staff of IterCulture and the community to enjoy the territory and local food together, as well as share their traditions.

PARTNER : Hermete was created in 1997 and mainly works in Valpolicella. It proposes to realize social and cultural projects for the community and for the territory, having quality and innovation has big targets. Hermete highly believes in networking, this is why it operates at a local, national and European level with

partners that seriously and passionately believe that education and culture are essential tools to the development and the growth of our society.

PROJECT : This is the sixth workcamp organized in Valpolicella. The project is promoted by Hermete, a local cooperative that promotes the social and cultural project, and by the group of young local people that organized the previous five Valpo workcamps editions. The aim of the workcamp is to create opportunities for cultural sharing and exchange between volunteers and the local community and to promote active citizenship through work with children. PARTNERS : The workcamp is organized by Creatività Poliedrica, a group of young people of the territory that dreams to renovate a building in Dolcè to open there a Policaffe, which is a space where people will be able to exchange their dreams and passion collaborating with other people in a space rich in ideas.

Together with Creatività Poliedrica there will be Hermete, a local cooperative that promotes social and cultural events, that have already organized several workcamps in the surroundings. Hermete was created in 1997 and mainly works in Valpolicella. It proposes to realize social and cultural projects for the community and for the territory, having quality and innovation as big targets. Hermete highly believes in networking, this is why it operates at a local, national and European level with partners that seriously and passionately believe that education and culture are essential tools to the development and the growth of our society.

PROJECT : Creatività Poliedrica is formed for a group of young people of the Valdadige district. The project aims to empower and active participation in and of the community. This camp wants to be an occasion for internationals to discover our culture and create a meeting and development spot for all of us. It also wants to be a moment for our young people to meet and realize a new great community. We hope that there's gonna be much more of it after this camp! By joining this workcamp you will contribute to the Sustainable Development Goals: **Sustainable Communities-SDG11**.

WORK : The volunteers will collaborate in the requalification of the building that during the last two years has been abandoned by the community because of the pandemic. Alongside with the manual work,

PARTNER : The camp is organized by Lunaria in collaboration with "Giovani insieme". The association is composed of young people for young people founded in October 1998 in Carignano with the aim of protecting, promoting and enhancing artistic, historical and architectural heritage, nature and the environment, by proposing summer work camps for young volunteers from all over Europe.

PROJECT : The workcamps in Carignano were started to restore some rooms in a building in the historical center of the town. Through this project volunteers have the opportunity to recover Carignano's architectural heritage and enjoy the environment whilst meeting young people from all over the world. Moreover "Giovani insieme" organizes different local events such as summer camps for local children, cultural exhibitions, etc. By joining this workcamp you will contribute to the Sustainable Development Goals: **LifeOnLand-SDG15** and **ClimateAction-SDG13**.

WORK : The aim of the project is to restore Villa Bona, a wonderful historical villa of the 18th century and the surrounding park to make it usable for public events, concerts, exhibitions etc.

Volunteers will work to implement the city forest, planted by the locals 30 years ago to make it more usable by the community. The work will be close to the river Po in a protected area called "Parco fluviale del Po" where the volunteers will also cut bamboo to protect the endemic vegetation and clean paths and weeds; painting some benches in public gardens in the village and also fences. The work inside the Villa Bona will be scratching wooden doors and painting them. There could also be cleaning work in some bell towers and churches. The volunteers will be also involved in the creation of a big mural "I VOLUNTEER" representing the workcamps season in Villa Bona 2022. Together with the international volunteers there will be a group of local youngsters involved in the same activities. Local volunteers will be Teenagers (14-17) and volunteers from an association called AU.DI.DO (autonomy for disabled people). Every week the volunteers will go to two retirement homes to present their countries. The volunteers will also meet an association that runs a project of taking care of refugees, in this way they can really see how that emergency is managed in Italy. Some Carignano's families will host the volunteers for a dinner in the house to share culture and way of life. The central idea of the workcamp is to exchange traditions and explore other cultures so please be ready to present something typical of your country (a dance, a song, a game, a typical dish, a custom etc.)

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD : The volunteers are going to stay in a building with beds, communal bathrooms with 2 showers and hot water and a kitchen. Bedrooms are provided with 4 to 6 beds per room.

The volunteers are responsible for the cleaning and cooking. Food is provided by the host organization. Volunteers must be equipped with a sleeping bag (or sheets), pillowcase and towels.

LOCATION AND LEISURE : The town of Carignano (8700 inhabitants) is situated on the left bank of the river Po approximately 20 Km from Torino and within the Regional Parco Fluviale (park of the river). Its center is of typical "piedmontese" style, characterized by an ancient core with medieval archways and a baroque cathedral. The town's surroundings offer sites of architectural and naturalistic interest, it is also possible to reach Turin easily, as there are frequent coaches to the city. During the free time there are many exciting things to do such as visit the open market of Carignano and take part in some local events. PARTNERS : Tularù is a cultural and agricultural project which rose to a start-up after a few years. As a center of sustainable production, their main goal is to use the cultural value of the traditional production techniques in order to create participation. According to them, the bread produced on their farm is not their bread. It is the bread of the territory because everyone has been involved in the production. For that, they use sustainable practices in agriculture and organize events connected to them. You can have an overview of the activities organized by the center : www.tularu.it (in Italian).

PROJECT : Through the work produced on the work-camp, the volunteers and the locals are going to prepare everything for the feast (a small festival organized around the farmers' work). In 6 years they have created a local network After the Feast in Tularù, volunteers will be involved in other activities with local associations in Cittaducale, like cleaning rural walks or others. By joining this workcamp you will contribute to the Sustainable Development Goals: **SustainableCommunities -SDG11, SustainableConsumption&Production-SDG12, and LifeOnLand-SDG15**

WORK : A Feast is an event around the agricultural activities going along with a small festival, with music, workshops, and events. All the following tasks will be done by the volunteers:

- Preparation of the interior and exterior spaces in Tularù
- Assistance in the kitchen, reaping and harvesting by hand during and after the feast.
- Public reception.
- Reaping and harvesting by hand during the feast.
- Collaboration with other local associations for social works like cleaning rural walks or others.

One big part of the work is the self-organization and the group work. There are a lot of things to do, but we want you to participate in how these things can be done. It's important to come with a proactive attitude, knowing that sometimes you will do things without us. Being an agricultural activity, the dates of the Feasts should be 22nd , 23rd, 24st July, but they are not fixed in advance since they mostly depend on the weather. In case of bad weather, other tasks will be performed.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD : The volunteers will be accommodated in the tents provided by the host or by the volunteers if preferred, close to the farmhouse where the local staff lives. LOCATION AND LEISURE : Tularù is located on the top of Mount Ponzano, in a hilly/mountain (850 m, asl) area, quite wild. The nearest village is Calcariola, a 200 inhabitants countryside, at 5km away from the

farm. Nevertheless, the nearest village where it is possible to find a bar and a small supermarket is Grotti, at 6km and 350 meters of height difference from Tularù. **TERMINAL** : Roma (Fiumicino and Ciampino Airport). Train Station: Roma Tiburtina. Bus Station: Rieti The satellite coordinates are 42.366999 – 12.939780. You can arrive in Rieti by bus from Roma Tiburtina station (1 hour and a half of travel, one bus every 30 minutes).

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS : Extra fee of 20€. The project is fully self-financed. However, a common budget to support the food costs for special needs will be done with the 20€ extra-fee that has to be given at the volunteer's arrival.

PARTNERS : Lunaria and Cilento Youth Union have organized several successful workcamps in the last years and this is the third camp supporting the Stella community. Cilento Youth Union is a youth NGO started in Rofrano (SA) in 2015, targeting Italian youth with fewer opportunities from the south of Italy and specifically from the Cilento area. This workcamp is co-organized by the Smak Association, which implements a programme to encourage creativity through the application of ceramic art.

PROJECT : Stella Cilento is a small village included in the National Park of Cilento, Diano and Alburni, UNESCO World Heritage Site. The local population conveys a noble and ancient Cilento tradition: the oral story of fairy tales. The aim of the project is to merge, through art, nature and culture. The activities aim to improve the path called "La Scala Santa – Il Sentiero Sacro del Monte Stella ", using natural waste materials to set up, along the route, pieces of art representative of a typical Cilentan fairy tale, chosen together with the volunteers. This work should stimulate and support the conservation of the environment and natural resources, communicating their inspiring values in an original way. The work camp will end with the Cuntaria Fairy Tale Festival. By joining this workcamp you will contribute to the Sustainable Development Goals: **SustainableCommunities-SDG11** and **LifeOnLand-SDG15**.

PARTNERS : Lunaria and Cilento Youth Union have organized several successful workcamps in the last years. Cilento Youth Union is a youth NGO started in Rofrano (SA) in 2015, targeting Italian youth with fewer opportunities from the south of Italy and specifically from the Cilento area. This workcamp is co-organized by Faro Association, which implements and promotes the widespread music festival BLOC FEST. The collaboration between Faro Association and Cilento Youth Union aims to enhance the long-standing expertise with young volunteers with a multicultural context that mixes in specific formation, art and environment through the festival experience. By joining this workcamp you will contribute to the Sustainable Development Goals: **SustainableCommunities-SDG11** and **LifeOnLand-SDG15**.

PROJECT : The festival will take place in Pollica (Salerno - Italy), acknowledged area for the discovery of the Mediterranean Diet (UNESCO intangible asset), and it will take place from the 5th August 2022 till Sunday the 7th August 2022.

The project therefore aims to merge, thought art and formation, two different dimensions: environment and culture. The activities point to improve the festival experience and learn how to enhance its environmental sustainability and cohesion with the local context, developing strategies and ideas to minimize transport impact and waste generation. This work will stimulate volunteers in experimenting a sustainable approach within a protected area through an all-embracing experience.

Pollica municipality counts, in its whole territory, also Acciaroli, Pioppi, Celso, Cannicchio and Galdo Cilento hamlets. All the areas are fully

immersed within the Mediterranean scrub, rich in protected species of fauna and flora, with a peculiar biodiversity and environmental/landscaping beauty. The rural and inner area of the Celso hamlet (twenty minutes from the Acciaroli's sea) is lived by friendly and hospitable and loveable citizens, always ready for chit-chats! **TERMINAL:** The closest airports are Napoli and Rome. Nearest train Station Vallo della Lucania. **SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS :** This project is supported by the European Solidarity Corps. Food and accommodation are covered by the European Union. PARTNERS : "Il Mondo in una Stanza" is an association based on the social promotion and non-professional sport and is supported by the municipality of Carsoli, in collaboration with many corps active in this territory. The straight relations between the different entities enable them to make artistic, social and human rights operations more efficient.

PROJECT: After the realization of 5 manual and renovation workcamps for the Carsoli community, the local group decided to work on the realization of promotional material and to raise awareness of peace and human rights through the realization of a short film. By joining this workcamp you will contribute to the Sustainable Development Goals: **Sustainable Communities-SDG11**

WORK : The volunteers, international and local will be engaged in an activity that aims to develop the skills required to conceive, write, shoot and edit an audiovisual project for cinema, TV and/or web and social. This development was deeply favored by the proximity with Rome and the links between the commune and the capital. This territory is covered with numerous woods and a large part of it is considered a protected area. Carsoli area also houses impressive caves, entered on a Site of Community Importance, with numerous pathways. The volunteers will have the opportunity to visit them and other beautiful natural areas. We are preparing a program of proposals with cultural and leisure activities for volunteer's free time, based on our past experiences. PARTNERS : The workcamp is organized by Lunaria in collaboration with 3 Naples associations operating in the eastern suburbs of Naples. The Association Noi@Europe with the aim of providing information on European mobility opportunities and other study, work and research opportunities for young people, also developing project ideas in the field of youth exchanges, culture, training and active citizenship. The association "TerradiConfine", a voluntary organization which supports active citizenship among young people. The association deals with urban regeneration of the territory, social justice and anti-mafia. The working methods refer to non-formal education with the aim of creating an active community in defense of the common good and the Cooperative "VeSpe - Verde Speranza" that maintains green spaces, works for territorial development and social inclusion

PROJECT : The idea of the workcamps is the result of the meeting and synergy of these three realities operating in the eastern suburbs of Naples. The idea of the project stems from the need of the staff and volunteers of these three organizations to recover some public spaces in the eastern suburbs of Naples, where they work and live. For this reason, it was decided to join forces and organize an international workcamp to help redevelop the waterfront in the San Giovanni a Teduccio neighborhood and the surrounding green areas to make these places, central to the daily life of the community, accessible and with a sufficient standard of services. By joining this workcamp you will contribute to the Sustainable Development Goals: **SustainableCommunities-SDG11**

WORK : Volunteers will work a maximum of 6 hours per day, 5 days per week (weekends off). The camp aims to rehabilitate the waterfront area of the San Giovanni a Teduccio neighborhood and the green areas nearby. The neighborhood is well connected to the historic center of Naples. **TERMINAL**: The nearest airport is 'Napoli Capodichino'. Nearest train station "Napoli Centrale - Piazza Garibaldi".
