<b>ORGANISATION</b>	<p>When August comes – so do more than 55.000 beautiful people, including 15.000 volunteers, ready for the most picturesque festival in Denmark: 'Smukfest'. <b>WORK</b>	<p>The festival will need your help to set up the festival and take it down, therefore you will work before and after the festival. The festival lasts from August 3rd to 7th, where you will have some days off to enjoy it. But you will also be joining a team that talks to the festival guests about sustainability, and the importance of recycling.</p>

	<p>You will be part of a team of volunteers building the festival. It is manual work and it will be an advantage with knowledge of tools, but it is not required.</p> <p>Your tasks will change from day to day, where you might help set up a stage one day, build a bar the next or carry fences. A team leader will instruct you on what to do.</p> <p>All volunteers on the production team meet at 9.30 every day and work until 18:00.</p> <p>It is all about having fun and everybody has a duty to think positive thoughts and give and receive lots of hugs.</p>
<p><b>ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD</b></p>	<p><b>Accommodation:</b> Volunteers will have to bring their own tents, sleeping mats and sleeping bags. There will be toilets installed and bath facilities everywhere you go.</p> <p><b>Food:</b> There are no kitchen facilities at the festival, but the festival provides 3 meals a day. Before and after the festival, all drinks – except beers – are free. During the festival, you will be given a bracelet by the festival. You can use this bracelet to get 3 meals and 3 drinks each day, in all food stands at the festival site and camping sites.</p> <p><b>Bathroom facilities:</b> Bath and toilet facilities are available at the festival. It is possible to do your laundry for free, before and during the festival.</p>
<p><b>LOCATION AND LEISURE</b></p>	<p>Skanderborg is a small town in an area known for its beautiful lakes and forests. Not far from Skanderborg you will find Aarhus, the second largest town in Denmark. The festival itself is located close to the town, situated in the local forest and right by the lake.</p> <p>It is free to enjoy the beautiful nature of Skanderborg, but some activities might require an extra charge. The host will not cover additional charges.</p>
<p><b>SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS</b></p>	<p>In regards to COVID-19, it is our ambition to complete our Work Camps this summer, but it is essential for us that our volunteers feel safe during the time they spend at our camps. This is why we constantly keep ourselves updated on the situation and we follow the Danish government's instructions. Furthermore, we are ready to answer any questions that you might have, and we will keep all our volunteers updated right up until the start of the Work Camp.</p>

	<p>Your Work Camp host will have guidelines on how to handle COVID-19 during your stay, including how to handle isolation and enforcement of government guidelines.</p> <p>For security reasons, the host cannot have volunteers with hearing or sight disabilities. For other physical disabilities, it depends on whether the volunteer can do manual work for several hours since the work is about construction and is very physical.</p> <p>English will be the only language spoken. All participants must be willing to speak English, even though being from the same country or have trouble with the English language. Try your best!</p> <p>We will advise you to bring warm clothes that are fit for outdoor work and might get dirty. Unfortunately, we cannot control the weather, so it is a good idea to bring rain clothes too.</p>
<p><b>TRAVEL INFO</b></p>	<p><b>Nearest airport:</b> Billund Airport  <b>Nearest bus/train station:</b> Skanderborg Train Station</p> <p><b>Meeting point and Time:</b>  Meeting Point: Dyrehaven 7, 8660 Skanderborg (Capri), which is 3 km from Skanderborg Station. It is possible to take a local bus instead of walking.  Arrival Time: 12:00 and 17:00 on July 22nd.  Departure Time: 12:00 on August 10th</p> <p><b>AIR TRAVEL</b>  Arrival at Billund Airport:  To make it to your meeting point in time, your flight must arrive no later than 15:00 on the first camp day.  From the airport, you take a bus to Vejle Station. The bus departs in 30-60 min. From there, you take a train directly to Skanderborg Station. The train departs every hour. After a small walk, you will reach the meeting point.  Total travel time from the airport to the meeting point will be approximately 1 hour.  The travel cost from the airport to the meeting point is approx. 15€.</p> <p>Arrival at Copenhagen Airport:  To make it to your meeting point in time, your flight must arrive no later than 13:00 on the first camp day.  From the airport, you take a direct train to Skanderborg St. The train departs every hour. After a small walk, you will reach the meeting point.</p>

	<p>Total travel time from the airport to the meeting point will be approximately 3 hours. The travel cost from the airport to the meeting point is approx. 55€.</p> <p><b>LONG-DISTANCE BUS / TRAIN</b> Arrival at Vejle bus/train station. To make it to your meeting point in time, your bus/train must arrive no later than 16:00 on the first camp day. From Vejle St., you take a train directly to Skanderborg Station. The train departs every hour. After a small walk, you will reach the meeting point. Total travel time from Vejle St. to the meeting point will be approximately 30 min. The travel cost from Vejle St. to the meeting point is approx. 10€.</p> <p>Further details on travel displays and purchasing of train/bus tickets will be provided in your infosheet after acceptance. If you are not able to make it in time to the meeting point, please consider arriving one day early and book a hostel.</p>
