#### **RAIL TRAVEL**



Derby is the nearest mainline train station.

Accommodation is approximately 15–20 mins away from Derby Train Station, and 5–10 mins from Derby Bus Station.

The event venue is approximately 30 mins away (on public transport) from Derby Station. The address is: University of Derby, Kedleston Road, Derby, DE22 IGB. and a 10-minute drive from Derby Station.

#### **PLAN YOUR TRAVEL**

UK has recently experienced a wave of rail strikes which severely disrupted travel across the country. We highly recommend you plan all your travel in advance and prepare for possible delays and disruptions to your journey.

#### **DERBY BUSES**





Contactless payments are widely accepted around the UK including on public transport (i.e. local buses)

The currency of the UK is the pound sterling (GBP) During your stay on the project, all your accommodation, food, and transport during the programme is provided for by us. You will only need pocket money to buy occasional food and drinks while out, and maybe some souvenirs.

We advise you to change a small amount of money (perhaps £30 - £40) at the airport when you arrive.

#### **VISA COSTS**

UK visa fees will be reimbursed for participants from non-EU countries (but please note we can only pay if the visa application is successful).

We will reimburse up to  $\in$ 200 per participant.



BREXIT



You can cross the UK border using a passport which should be valid for the whole time you are in the UK. Please check you posess a valid document before you travel. EU ID cards will no longer be accepted.



#### **TRAVEL INSURANCE**



All participants should ensure that they have comprehensive travel insurance which includes cover for all eventualities relating to Covid. We will not be responsible for any injury or loss - medical, financial, or otherwise.

You should check what the entry requirements are for when you return to your home country. Some countries may require Covid testing.



Some places recommend you wear a face mask so it is a good idea to bring spare masks with you. Covid tests are available for purchase in most pharmacies.

You are asked to arrive at the accommodation on 10th August to check in after 2pm, your departures will take place after breakfast on 17th August.



Remember that when visiting the UK you will need a UK power adapter for electrical items. This is a three point adapter and can be purchased in most travel stores and airports.



During KA3 Turning Points we will be based in block B with access to other common areas. You will be given a more detailed instructions about the venue itself upon your arrival.



#### ACCESSIBILITY



All areas of the campus are fully accessible to anyone with mobility requirements via lifts, ramps, handrails and level entrance ways. The hallways and walkways are wide enough for a wheelchair in all areas. Hearing loops are available in the lecture theatres but not the classrooms. All residential delegates will receive a pass for the entire week of the event.





Derby offers are range of shops in the city centre. Most shops in the UK will accept cash (notes and coins) or debit/credit cards, although some are now card only – they usually have a sign saying this on the front entrance. We recommend you check the conversion rates and bank fees with your bank prior to your travel to the UK. Please see the above map for shops, cafes and restaurants available on campus.

#### **DIETARY REQUIREMENTS**



Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be provided during the duration of the project.

We will do our best to cater to your dietary requirements, and allergies- it is vital you indicate these on the registration form.

Breakfast and lunch will be served on campus.

Dinner will be served at a different venue. Details of it will be shared on your arrival.

University of Derby offers a multi-faith centre for anyone who requires a religious space.

### **STAYING CONNECTED**

Now the UK left the EU you might be subject to additional roaming fees when using your phone. Please check this information with your network provider prior to your arrival in the UK.

Wifi will be available throughout Campus.



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#### **SPORTS CENTRE**



University has offered us a voucher for each delegate to be able to have one free session at the onsite gym during your stay. Additional sessions would need to be paid for at the standard visitor rate.

#### **WHAT TO BRING**

Alcohol is allowed but please remember you must either buy it from Duty Free at the airport or pack it in your checked luggage.

Please do not bring food that needs cooking, because we will not have the resources for this. We can provide items such as cutlery and paper plates.

MAXIMUM TIME ALLOWED for each country will be 3 MINUTES! You will be given time to prepare the activity with the other participants from your country.

Also if possible please bring a large flag of your country – we will use these to decorate the walls during the week as well.
