About the project

- ESC HPA project
- Application submitted in 2022, implementation starting in 2023
- Planned for three years
- Priorities of 2022 call: Supported projects should aim to mobilise volunteers around enhancing access to
 cultural heritage for all, or reconversion of heritage infrastructure with a high social purpose and a low carbon
 footprint. New participatory and intercultural approaches to heritage will be promoted.
- Planned two activities (workcamps) for each year + complementary activities
- Total: 66 participants

SDA-ESC-H1 - ESC Farmstudio - A Centre of Contemporary Art

Replacement for Grabstejn Castle, yet to be approved by the EACEA

When: 17.07.2023 – 31.07.2023

Where: Farmstudio, Vysoká

- Goals and objectives: Farmstudio focuses on contemporary live art. The area is undergoing a gradual recon-struction and the goal of the workcamp is to help with this reconstruction.
- Target group: The workcamp is suitable for volunteers interested in contemporary art, cultural heritage and nature who are not afraid of manual work.
- Work: Work will be diverse and manual, volunteers can choose according to their interest and physical abilities.
- Accommodation: Residential building in two big rooms with 14 beds


SDA-ESC-H2 - ESC Veseli Castle

When: 06.08.2023 – 20.08.2023

• Where: Tvrz Veselí, Pocinovice

- Goals and objectives: The mission of the association is to renovate the castle to its original form and reopen its gates to the public again - mainly for cultural and educational purposes.
- Target group: The workcamp is suitable for fans of history, and culture and for those seeking insights into the Czech countryside.
- Work: Work tasks are divided into three parts including the construction of a wire fence, work in the castle park as well as cleaning up work in the castle clearing debris in the castle cellar or repair of the stone wall.
- Accommodation: provided in a family house in the village Pocinovice
