
This is an exclusive project for those who are active in the field of youth trainings; particularly those who work with groups as trainers, facilitators, and educators.

We aim to gather a group of participants with **varied backgrounds** and levels of experience. This will enhance the informal learning process, through the sharing of knowledge and skills between participants.

Priority will be given to those who commit to the **3 training courses** as we believe that maximum learning impact will come from attending the whole learning cycle.

As we are aiming for a greater impact, we will also prioritize applicants who already have or are part of an **active youth organisation** where they can implement educational activities.



The second training focuses a lot on professional identity through position personal development, how to ourselves as trainers/facilitators/youth workers.




ADVANCED TRAINING FOR TRAINERS
