Youth exchange for teenagers from July 6 to 20, 2024



- Experience 2 weeks in intercultural teenagers collective life
- Develop your sense of initiative and discover different forms of expression
- Improve your self-confidence
- Learn to express your ideas and transform them into artistic works
- Develop your ability to work in an autonomous way

Step 1, Feeling : Over the first few days you'll get to know each other and build a group in a fun and dynamic way. You'll have a space to define and understand art and change.

Step 2, Sharing : Come and meet local artists and discover different forms of expression to broaden your thinking, your imagination and your creativity.

Step 3, Taking action : Group workshops to create and organise an exhibition for the residents of the castle and surrounding area. The final days will be devoted to summarising and formalising what you have learned from your experience at Le Créneau.

In a dynamic of non-formal education, the participants will be able to " make and live together " and each participant will be in responsible for the daily life of the group. This tool is very important for a real encounter: the teenagers will elaborate their own menus, cook in groups, do the cleaning and organise their activities. Exchanges during cooking, housework, meals together and leisure activities are the base of interculturality.
