THE AIM OF THIS TRAINING

Solidarités Jeunesses means : popular education by everyone, for everyone. The movement's associations set up and run collective, multi-facetted reception centres where they experiment with approaches to living together. Every summer, intercultural exchanges put these values into practice with young people from different social and cultural backgrounds.

This training aims to:

improve the **educational quality** of youth exchanges and other intercultural initiatives share **tools** and encourage peer-to-peer training and the **exchange of practices** enable SJ members (animators, former volunteers, etc.) to acquire **skills** and **find their place** in SJ be a stepping stone in the SJ **commitment** process.

The aim of this training course is to co-construct the keys to making youth exchanges a constructive experiment in collective intelligence.

It will help to prepare different workshops for these intercultural projects (finalising the programme, copreparing workshops, links with partners and speakers, etc.) within a Solidarités Jeunesses delegation.

The training will be enriched by the participants, who will share their experiences and skills.

FACILITATORS

HANNAH BEAUMONT is a popular education facilitator specialising in interculturality, conflict management, teamwork and training for trainers. She has run a number of international work camps and youth exchanges.

NADÈGE ROPERT has been a long-term volunteer, facilitator, coordinator and administrator with Solidarités Jeunesses. She has coordinated and led intercultural projects and organised workshops and training courses on a range of subjects (interculturality, leadership, community life and project coordination, etc.).

Both are active in popular education, and are convinced of the practical role played by SJ in bringing about social change.
