Your tasks as a volunteer in Jugendwerk will be...

- ... to participate in the intercultural learning project **“Active Culture”** (check out what

- ... to take part in our project **“Spracheteria”** – an intercultural meeting with focus on  
language exchange. You have the possibility to prepare games, choose movies and  
topics and to bring your own ideas for the success of the project. You are also

- ...to **participate in different seminars** in the weekends (!). After attending the seminars,  
you will be prepared for leading camps in the summer and winter holidays.

- ...to take part in **organizing and supporting youth camps**: At the end of your project, you will take part in a youth camp. You will help in preparation, realization and evaluation of the youth camp and work together with other youngsters.
- ... to **take part in organizing and supporting seminars**: You will help during the preparation and realization of our seminars, be responsible for the materials & stuff for the seminars.
- ... to **support the Jugendwerk Team in the office** (almost every day you will help in the office: answering emails, driving somewhere, going shopping, being responsible for the stuff what we use for the camps, tidying up, cooking, organizing seminars and other events)
