



Ribadavia


Ribadavia is a town and municipality located in the southwest of the province of Ourense, autonomous community of Galicia, Spain and a former part of the Kingdom of Galicia. The urban area lies on the right bank of the Miño river and the last course of the Avia river. It is the capital of the comarca of the Ribeiro.





The town was declared a **Historic- Artistic ensemble** in 1947. Near the Campo da Feira, one can find the ruins of the **Castle of the Sarmientos**, the Counts of Ribadavia, dating from the XVth century. It still preserves the interior, towers and walls.

Ribadavia is not only linked for wine, but also to the presence of **Jewish culture and history**. Its Jewish quarter is the most significant in Galicia, both because of its importance and because of its fine state of repair.

The Municipal Youth Information Office (OMIX Ribadavia) has been created to support the youth of our municipality within the framework of non-formal and informal education.




Accomodation and food

Accommodation and food are fully covered.


- You will be staying in the Garden Lodge Hostal Evencio close to the city center.

- There will also be two coffee breaks a day, with fruit and Galician sweets to keep your energy levels up.



























Getting there ?



Vigo airport:

- When you arrive to Vigo airport, you take the bus Vitrasa A and in 30min it takes you to the stop Tva de Vigo 7, which is 15 mins walking until the main bus station.
- From Vigo bus station there are two Monbus buses per day (or more, depends on the period) that take you directly to Ribadavia.

Santiago de Compostela airport:

- From Santiago de Compostela airport, you take the <u>bus Nr. 6</u> to the main bus/railway station of Santiago in 20-30 minutes.
- From there, there are regular buses and trains that bring you to Ourense.
- From the Ourense bus station you take the Monbus Line XG604 that takes you to Ribadavia.

Porto airport:

- From Porto airport you can take the <u>Flixbus</u> to reach Vigo, the capital of Galicia.
- From the same bus station, the Monbus Line XG623 to Ourense will bring you directly to Ribadavia. It runs two times a day.




Getting there ?



From Ourense to Ribadavia

• If you arrive in Ourense by train, to get to Ribadavia, you need to take a bus that departs from the bus station, which is located right next to the train station, on the right as you exit. It's very important to consider your arrival time in Ourense when buying tickets, as there are few buses going to Ribadavia on Sundays. Below, we provide a picture of the schedule (Sundays' times are circled at the bottom right), since there may be errors on the website. The last bus departs at 9:00 PM.



A creative country presentation (theatre, posters, stereotypes..), music in your own language, traditional food/drink from your home country.





Basic Spanish / Galician words

Galician weather:
