The volunteers will have an opportunity to live together in a group of people of different nationalities, so they can learn many interesting things from each other, cook together, raise their level of cultural tolerance and practice English and Spanish. In addition, it's a great experience to work in a team, especially in an international one. It's a project where you can show all your resolution capacity, creativity, and make some core memories! Being with the local community, the volunteers will have a chance to learn about Spanish culture.

We are looking for volunteers who are decisive and willing to lead a group, develop her/his entrepreneurship skills, taking initiative and intercultural skills, to do manual and organizational work. **You need to be flexible and empathetic** and also open to get to know new people from new cultures. **Driver's license and basic Spanish will be highly valued.**

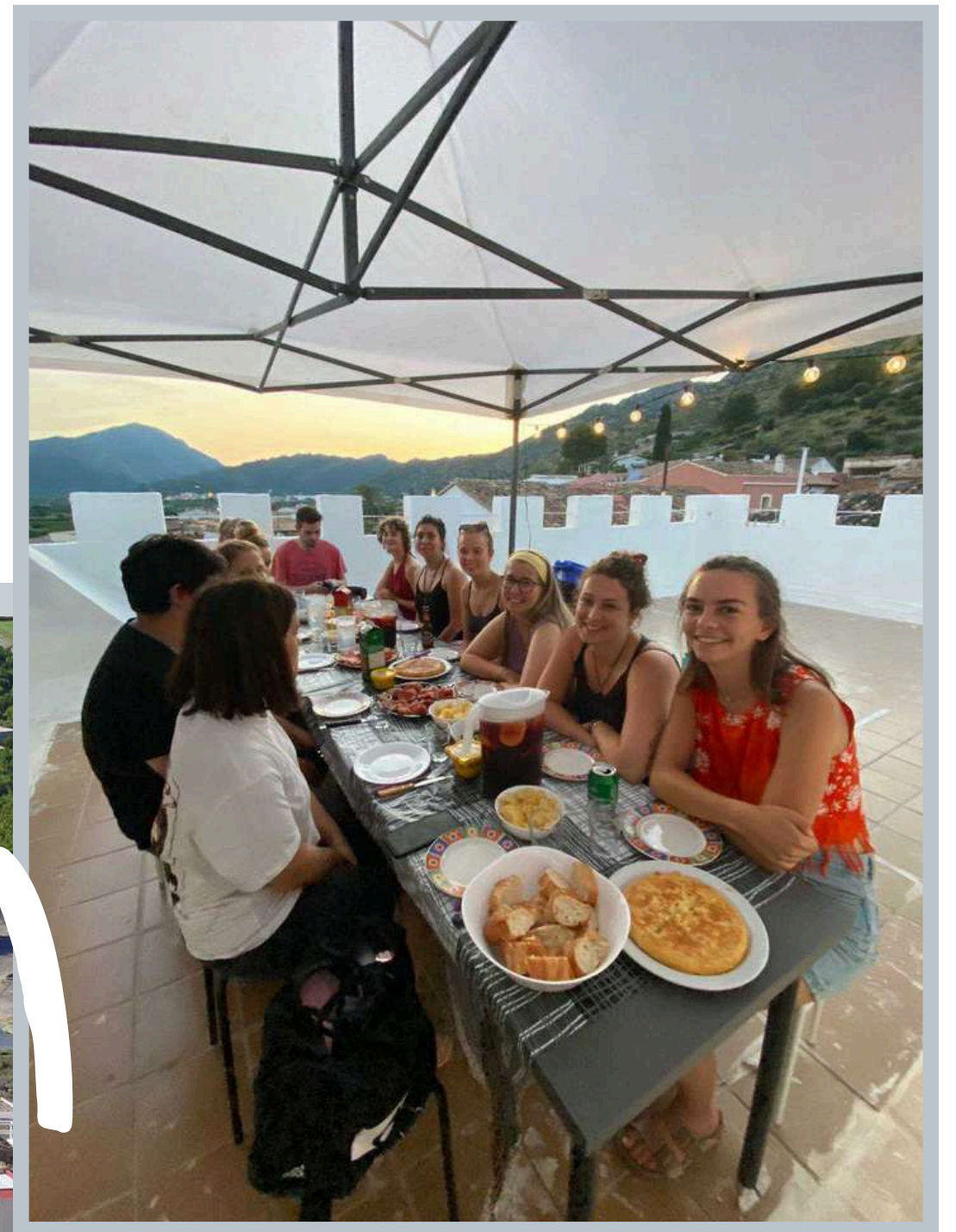




# ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

The house includes a nice kitchen in which the volunteers will cook for themselves so bring some recipes from your country. Food expenses are covered by De Amicitia. Sheets and pillows are available but you need to bring your sleeping bags (check with the organizer).

# LOCATION, LEISURE

Sanet is a small town in the southwest of Spain close to Dénia (Comunidad de Valencia) in beautiful countryside, surrounded by hills which are great for hiking - there are a lot of hiking trails to discover. Dénia is only 10 minutes by car. The house is located right in the middle of town, so there are great opportunities to interact and socialize with the locals and to truly experience the Spanish countryside. Furthermore, the volunteers can make excursions to Ondara and El Vergel, local towns close to Sanet. The surrounding villages like Benimelli and Ràfol d'Almunia can also be visited. There will also be day trips to the beach which is about 15 minutes by car from Sanet if you have time.

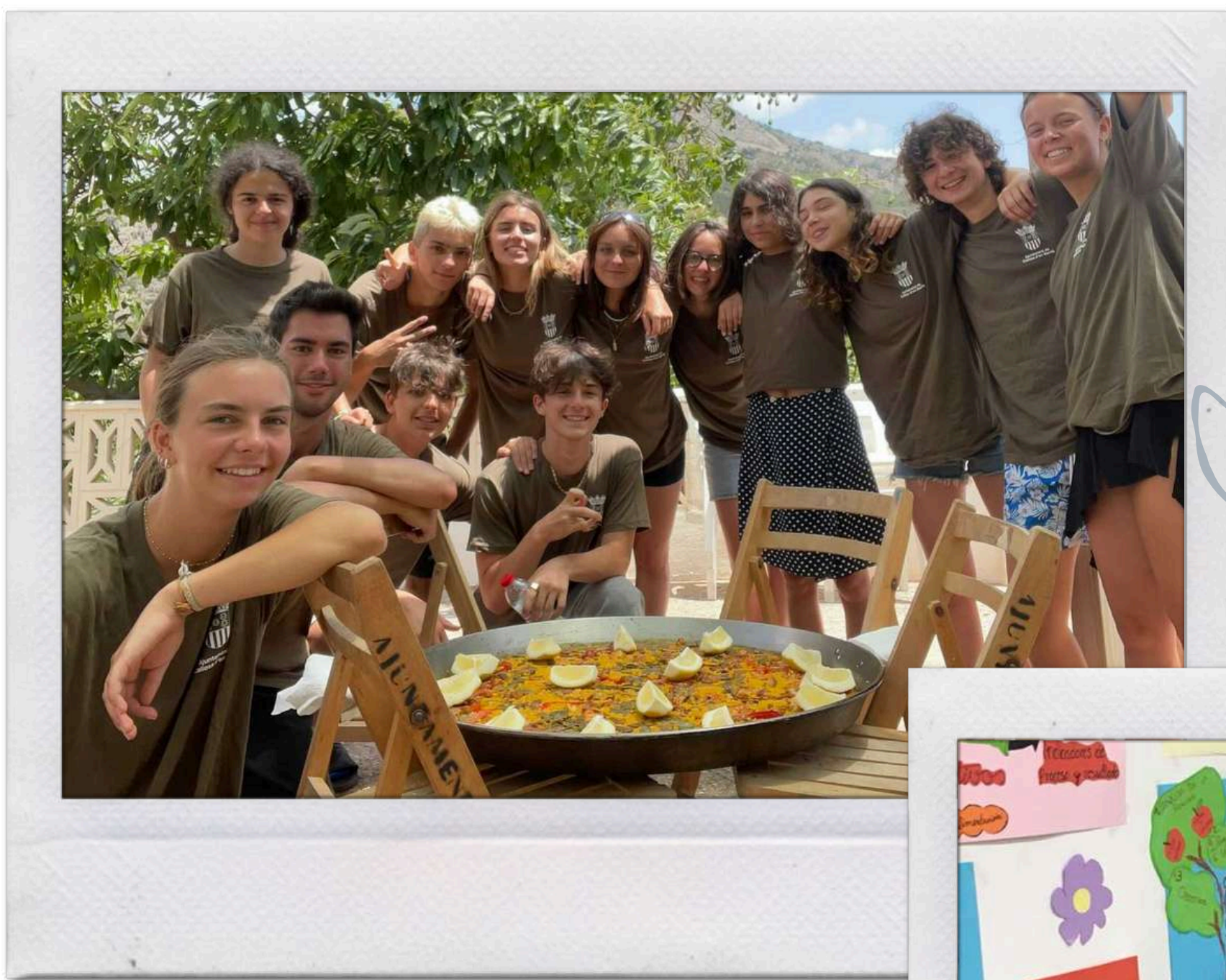




# INTERCULTURAL EVENING

# WHAT TO BRING WITH YOU

- ✔ Passport or/and identification card.
- ✔ EUROPEAN HEALTH CARD (or additional travel insurance).
- ✔ Sleeping bag
- ✔ Sun-cream (high factor), Insect repellent.
- ✔ Swimsuit, Sunglasses, Hat
- ✔ Walking shoes
- ✔ Flip flops or sandals to use in the water
- ✔ Towel, personal hygiene items (soap, shampoo, cream, tooth paste etc.).
- ✔ You can also bring your own instruments, some card or board games that you would like to share.
- ✔ **Remember that if you have any allergies or illnesses bring any medicine that you may need.**

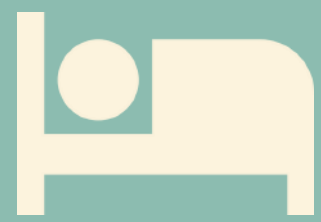

When you are packing your bag, please consider to travel with a **HAND LUGGAGE/BACKPACK** that you can take inside the flight, instead of CHECKED IN LUGGAGE.

# SOME BASIC RULES

- Please, keep in mind that any use of any drugs is illegal and forbidden.
- Abuse of alcohol is not allowed so no drinking during the projects activities.
- **Smoking is prohibited inside and outside the house. Please respect the others.**
- Noise and loud talking can disturb the other people on the campsite and village so we have to respect them.
- Every participant is responsible to keep her/his rooms and the common area clean. The house should be left as clean as when you arrived.

We encourage participants to use Wi-Fi/internet in a limited amount to engage better in group life.





# HOW TO GET TO THE MEETING POINT

There will be a pick up service from the **Denia Bus Station**.

You can buy the bus ticket from Alicante or Valencia Airport to Denia Bus Station in: <https://www.alsa.es/>

We recommend Alicante airport because you can take the bus at the airport that takes you to Denia (with a change in Benidorm) so it is easier than Valencia airport.

Please organise your **departure after 1 pm on the last day**. Our team will take **you** to the DENIA Bus Station at 7 am





# DOCUMENTATION

Due to the fact that this is a ESC Project you will have to comply with several documents to be able to participate in it and receive your pocket money (5,00 € per day) and travel expenses 275 € for those coming from other EU countries (Depends on the country ask to the organizer).

**Volunteers have to sign a contract to participate in the project. Misbehaving and failure to comply with house rules and obligations may lead to the cancellation of your participation, so please be aware that this is a volunteering project, not a simple holiday.**
