- the old bakery will be refurbished, you will do wood work and learn how to reuse material



Bauorden will pay a subsidy for travel costs of 180€ per volunteer.



Travel between the workcamps is usually by train and organised and paid for by the Bauorden.



In the workcamps there is sleeping accommodation and catering included.



Volunteers are accident insured through the Bauorden during the workcamps. Your own health insurance must be valid in Germany.



All volunteers receive a certificate of participation from the Bauorden.
