CONTEXT

The goal of our association is to put together people from different social and cultural backgrounds to create **diversity** in order to learn to live together, to get to know each other, and to **exchange** about our own experiences with **respect** and **tolerance** towards a better society.

Animation, as both an art form and a method, is at the intersection of **education**, **social inclusion**, and **cultural diversity**. It has the power to **engage communities** and **foster transformative experiences**. Together, we would like to take a look on how animation can be leveraged to **address** broader societal challenges and encourage **intercultural dialogue**.

THE AIM OF THIS SEMINAR

The aim of this 3-day seminar is to provide a unique opportunity for partner organizations to **meet**, **exchange** practices, and **explore** collaborative approaches to animation as a creative and social art form. By focusing on themes such as **collaboration**, **creativity**, and the **exchange of practices**, we aim to strengthen our connections and inspire **new initiatives**.



The seminar will offer a **dynamic space** to share knowledge, develop joint projects, and showcase best practices in animation across various contexts. This gathering will also **highlight the importance** of creativity in fostering active participation and community-building in our European projects.

Lastly, participants will have the chance to experience the inspiring setting of the **Château de Le Créneau**, a unique social and international hosting center located in the picturesque **Auvergne region**, known for its volcanic landscapes. The venue itself reflects the values of **collaboration** and **innovation** that are central to this seminar.

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

The main objectives and activities of the seminar are the following:

- Enable associations working with international groups to **meet** and **get to know** each other better: presentations of each association, their **pedagogical approaches**, and their **educational values**.
- Share approaches to animation in international projects, based on **successful experiences** and **challenges** encountered: how can animation become a political and transformative tool in our projects? How can we align animation practices with the **values** and **capacities** of our organizations? How can animation be used to foster **social transformation**? Are there specific themes worth exploring? What are the **key points** to watch out for?
- Discover new pedagogical **approaches** through exchanges between participants: associations that have developed **specific skills** in particular areas will be invited to present them.
- **Stimulate the development** of new collaborations and projects between partners: based on the exchanges that take place, identify the specific **needs** of associations (training, study visits) in the medium term.

INFORMATION

Le **Créneau** is one of the regional delegations of Solidarités Jeunesses. It is located in a **castle** in Montcombroux-les-Mines, in a rural area. It has been acting for 30 years for **social**, **educative** and **cultural** local development.

ACCOMODATION

The participants will be accommodate in the castle, in bedrooms of 3 to 6 people and will have at their disposal all the facilities of the hosting centre (dining room, showers and toilets).

DAILY LIFE

Seminar participants will share meals and evenings with the facilitators, employees and residents of Le Créneau. As far as possible, everyone is invited to take part in some of the daily tasks (meals, washing up), which is a way of getting to know the different people on the site.

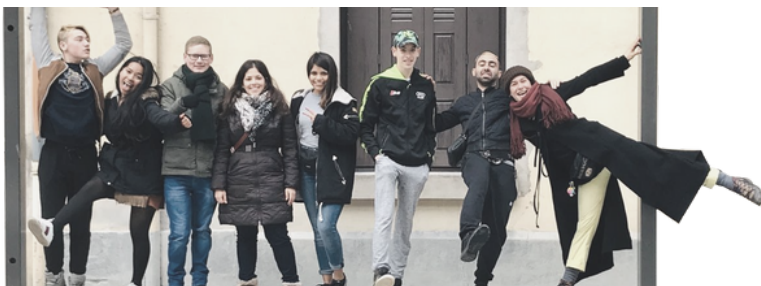
