
REGIONAL DELEGATIONS



VOLUNTEERING

Volunteering embodies an exchange, an encounter facilitated by individuals willing to contribute their time, energy, and fresh perspectives to projects of common interest. It fosters a welcoming community that offers valuable opportunities for personal growth and learning. Volunteering transcends mere activity; it's a multifaceted process supported by our partner associations before, during, and after project completion.

At SJ, volunteering isn't about humanitarian aid but rather intercultural exchange and local community initiatives. It's a global commitment that varies across countries, cultures, and project types. Volunteering unites diverse communities, local associations, individuals of all backgrounds, and local authorities. It's a powerful force for positive change and collective growth.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Group Life

Our workcamps typically bring together 8 to 12 volunteers from approximately 5 different nationalities, with an average age of 20 years. Volunteers share responsibilities for cooking and cleaning, so we encourage them to bring their favorite traditional recipes! Adult workcamps are open to volunteers aged 18 and above, with no specific age limit unless requested by a partner.

Qualifications

While no specific qualifications are required, volunteers must be motivated to help and open to experiencing life in a rural area alongside people from diverse backgrounds. Basic knowledge of English and French is helpful.

Campleaders

Each workcamp is supported by two campleaders who assist with organizing daily activities such as budget management, cooking, and recreational activities. Additionally, the host community often provides a technical leader for specific manual tasks, guiding volunteers in the methods and procedures involved.

Languages

The language used within the group depends on its composition and the language abilities of each volunteer. However, English and French are commonly spoken in our projects.

Accommodation

Volunteers will be accommodated in various settings, including rooms provided by local associations, tents, or schools, depending on the project and region.

Insurance

Solidarités Jeunesses provides insurance for accidents and civil liability. However, it does not cover illnesses during the workcamp. Volunteers must have their own insurance for travel and sickness.

Leisure Time

Workcamps are opportunities for volunteers to experience community life. Leisure activities are organized together, considering local conditions, group preferences, and available resources. Activities may include visiting tourist attractions, exploring the environment, and cultural evenings with locals. It's important for each volunteer to contribute to a positive and lively group dynamic!

Adult Workcamps

- No participation fee
- Workcamps typically last 2 3 weeks
- Working hours: 30 hours per week (mornings) Afternoons are dedicated to cultural, non-formal education activities or leisure activities

Teenager Workcamps

- Participation fee for teens: 250 euros, to be paid at least 3 weeks before the workcamp by bank transfer for EU citizens or in cash upon arrival for non-EU citizens.
- Medical questionnaires and parental authorisation forms must be uploaded on SJ intranet at least 3 weeks before the camp starts.
- Age Limit: 15 -17 years + one workcamp for 12-14 year-old volunteers
- Working hours: 25 hours per week (mornings) Afternoons are dedicated to cultural, informal education/recreational activities

Family Workcamp

- Participation fee 50€ for children and 100€ for adults
- Workcamps typically last 1 week
- Age: Between 5 and 15 for children, no age limit for adults

European Solidarity Corps/Volunteering Teams

- Open to EU and neighboring countries
- Travel costs partially reimbursed and pocket money provided

AN ALTERNATIVE PLACE IN PÉRIGORD

03/05 - 17/05 CONS/ENVI 7 vols 18+

PROJECT

Nestling in a lush green valley, the commune of Coly - St Amand lies at the heart of the Périgord Noir, an area rich in history! It's made up of two former communes that have decided to come together as one, and we'll be working to bring these formerly separate areas together as one.

The Ecocycle association is a third-place organisation that is developing a participatory activity project in the commune of Saint Amand de Coly and the surrounding area. These activities are strongly influenced by concerns about climate change.

A third place like Ecocycle in Coly-Saint-Amand is a shared space that brings together people, ideas and projects to encourage collaboration and social links. It's a place open to everyone, where you can work, talk, learn and sometimes even relax. Halfway between home and the workplace, a third place can host a variety of activities: workshops, cultural events, training courses or collective projects.

At Ecocycle, for example, there is a strong ecological and community dimension. It promotes recycling, creatively with reused materials, and the development of a shared garden. It's a place that supports local initiatives while creating a welcoming and inspiring environment for residents and visitors alike. In short, it's much more than just a building: it's a place for life, ideas and encounters!

WORK

On the mornings of the 2 weeks, you'll be actively involved in setting up the Ecocycle café. You'll be asked to build outdoor furniture out of pallet wood, and you'll continue the work started by a volunteer on signage inside the café. Whether you're a keen DIY enthusiast or just curious, this workcamp gives you the chance to make your own contribution to the building while discovering the richness and diversity of the dynamics of a third place. Join us for a friendly, rewarding and creative experience!

Location : Coly - St Amand (24120) is located in Périgord Noir, 10 km from the caves of Lascaux, between Périgueux and Brive.

Closest train station: Condat-Le-Lardin station.

Closest airports: Bordeaux-Mérignac or Toulouse-Blagnac.

Time and directions to the meeting point: TaThe meeting point is Condat-Le-Lardin station. You should get there on 28/05 between 5pm and 8pm. Departure is on the last day between 9am and 12pm maximum.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

You will be welcomed at the Ecocycle Café, located in the same area as the site. Sleeping accommodation in dormitories of 4 to 5 people. Meals will be prepared and eaten collectively in the café's kitchen and dining room. From time to time, you'll enjoy your meals in the company of café volunteers, reinforcing the warm, collaborative spirit that is so important to this project. Everyone will be able to help in the kitchen and share their favourite recipes. So don't forget to bring your gourmet ideas!

SJ06 THE FORTRESS OF FOURAS 1

PROJECT

Le Bugue is a picturesque little town in the heart of Périgord Noir, in the Dordogne department of the Nouvelle-Aquitaine region. Bordered by the peaceful waters of the Vézère, it is nestled in an enchanting natural setting, surrounded by wooded hills and landscapes typical of this region rich in history.

The town has been home to the Point-Org Association and its BriKaBrak festival for over 20 years now, an eclectic and friendly cultural event held every year around the Whitsun weekend. BriKaBrak stands out for its multi-disciplinary programme, combining street arts, live performances, music, theatre and entertainment for all ages. Its festive and accessible spirit makes it a not-to-be-missed event for locals and visitors in search of originality.

This festival embodies the spirit of sharing and cultural discovery, bringing generations together around captivating performances and a unique moment of conviviality in the Dordogne.

You'll be helping the association and its volunteers to prepare the festival. You'll discover the local people's sense of welcome and their energy to make it a time of joy and celebration. You'll also discover a region rich in history as you work with the other volunteers and the organisers to organise your programme of activities.

WORK

Immerse yourself in the world of the BriKaBrak festival by helping to prepare the site. You'll start by erecting a majestic circus tent, the heart of the event. Then, give free rein to your creativity by decorating the site to give it the vibrant colours of the festival. On the weekend of 7 and 8 June, get into the collective spirit by helping the volunteers to create some unforgettable moments of conviviality. Together, let's create a festive atmosphere and share in the magic of these two unique days!

LET'S BUILD THE HIKERS' SHELTER!

04/06 - 18/06 CONS 10 vols 18+

PROJECT

A small valley in the heart of a sublime alpine landscape, the remains of the 12th-century abbey of Clausonne, and a 300 km hiking trail that crosses the site. All this invites you to discover this rural area and its history! Here, for the past 30 years, a local association has been involved in preserving and promoting the site, as well as contributing to the life of Clausonne and writing its present-day history.

Last summer, work began on the construction of a hiker's shelter on the site. As this is a stage on an itinerary of ancient transhumance routes, you'll be contributing to welcoming cyclists and hikers for years to come.

This project is just one of the many initiatives in which international and local volunteers, the people on work integration programs, and other professionals have participated over the years.

You'll be staying at the Ferme du Faï, an old mountain farmhouse that's kept alive by a team of employees working on the renovation of the buildings, artists and musicians in artistic residences, hikers passing through, and the curious. Roll up your sleeves and join us on-site and in our collective living space!



You'll be working on a timber frame for a hiking shelter, located in the immediate proximity of the Abbey of Clausonne. A local carpenter will guide you in assembling the supporting structure, making the joints, and building the floor. Each day, two members of the group will rotate in preparing meals for the team; the menu will be defined in advance. You'll work on-site during the mornings from Monday to Friday.

Generally speaking, the work involves carpentry, preparing tools and meals, as well as organizing and setting up community life.

Location: The Clausonne site is a 20-minute walk from Ferme du Faï. Le Faï is 2 km from the village of Le Saix and 13 km from the town of Veynes. There's no Wi-Fi, so the connection is weak, but you'll meet people from all over the world!

Closest airports: Marseille - provence

Time and directions to the meeting point: Shuttle to Ferme
du Faï from Veynes-Dévoluy

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

You'll be accommodated in individual tents in the outdoor areas of the municipal gymnasium in the small town of Le Serres, with access to the building's sanitary facilities and kitchen.

Here, we take care with our food to reduce our environmental impact: we eat local as much as possible and reduce our meat consumption to twice a week.

Daily life is organized collectively: menus (vegetarian, vegan diets, etc.), shopping, activities, and so on.

LEISURE ACTIVITIES

The site is located just below the summit of Aujour Mountain, so the view may inspire you to discover the pleasure of the hike in your spare time. Indeed, this spot in the wilderness is ideal for enjoying mountain walking and wandering. You'll have the chance to discover the area in the company of a group of international volunteers, which will enrich your experience. Here, you'll be the protagonist of your stay: you'll organize together your free time with the support of our staff.





SJ09 THE FORTRESS OF FOURAS 2

PROJECT

SJ10 BETTER SHELTER

PROJECT

The workcamp will take place in the commune of Pont-de-Montvert, near Mont-Lozère in the heart of the Cévennes. The aim of the project is to help build a new town square. This square has historically been home to sports facilities, in particular the former tennis courts in the village. However, since their closure, this space has been more or less left to its own devices, serving as a parking lot and occasional storage area. Since 2018, the commune has planted trees and hedges and installed a playground for the village's children. Your mission: to continue beautifying and transforming this square so that it becomes a place for village gatherings and activities.



You'll be helping to restore this site, known as Place Molines. Following numerous consultations with village residents, objectives for the transformation of this place were listed. In 2024, volunteers created trellises to provide shade and seating. This year, a wooden kiosk-type shelter will be built on the square to enhance the facilities of this new square. In this way, you'll be helping to design a friendly, intergenerational leisure area, bringing freshness to the site by creating this shaded space, enhancing the setting: river Tarn, views of the Mont Lozère massif, peace and quiet, and finally making the place welcoming, safe and clean. 25h/week

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

The workcamp will take place in a particularly isolated area, where you will be accommodated in the village gîte. You will have access to sanitary facilities and a communal kitchen. Meals will be provided by the association and prepared in turn by the participants.

LEISURE ACTIVITIES

Far from the French metropolises, Lozère is nonetheless a very dynamic region. The region's activities revolve around local festivities, concerts and unspoilt natural areas (mountains, rivers, forests).


PROJECT

Eymet is a charming medieval Bastide town in the Périgord Pourpre region of the Dordogne department in the Nouvelle-Aquitaine region of France. Founded in 1270, this small town embodies the authenticity and charm of the Bastide towns, the fortified towns typical of southwestern France. Eymet is built around its central square, lined with arcades and bustling with cafés, restaurants and shops.

Its rich historical heritage can be seen in the cobbled streets, the fortified church of Saint-Etienne and the remains of its medieval castle, offering a journey back in time. History buffs will also appreciate the half-timbered and stone houses that bear witness to its past. Eymet is particularly well known for its strong British community, which contributes to its cosmopolitan atmosphere while preserving a Perigordian art of living.

Eymet's mill, located on the banks of the River Dropt, is one of the most emblematic symbols of this Bastide in the Périgord Pourpre. Full of history, it bears witness to the importance of mills in the medieval and modern economy of the region, where they were mainly used to grind the grain produced in the rich surrounding farmland.

You will take part in this architectural and human adventure by preparing the mill for summer events. You'll round off your stay by taking part in the local heritage and mill festival, which is held every year on the last weekend in June to kick off the summer season.

With the help of a specialist, you'll learn about the specific vegetation found along the banks of the river and look after it on the mill peninsula. Finally, you will take part in the design and organisation of the built heritage and mills festival, one of the town's great festive occasions.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

You'll stay in tents on our summer camp on the Moulin peninsula. Access to dry toilets and showers on site. Individual tents or tents for two will be provided, as well as foam trekking mattresses. Remember to bring your duvet and a pillow. You will prepare the menus together, meeting local producers and cooking their delicious seasonal produce. You'll share your meals together in the mill's majestic great hall, where you can spend unforgettable evenings afterwards. Don't forget to bring your own gourmet recipes!

LEISURE ACTIVITIES

Site visits, nature activities, you will build your own entertainment program with the animators and the other participants. We favor a discovery of the territory and these actors over consumption activities.

WORK

You will collaborate with the organization's volunteers in the preparation and setup of the festival (site barricading, parking, etc.). THE RECONSTRUCTION OF NEIGE ET

MERVEILLES

The <u>Neige & Merveilles</u> association welcomes you to the heart of the Mercantour National Park at an altitude of 1500 m, to work on the continuation of the Vallauria mining hamlet development project. You will discover an exceptional geological heritage and take part in a human and collective adventure which has lasted for more than 60 years. The Neige et Merveilles association has been working since its creation to revive this historic site in order to offer a haven of peace promoting discovery, meetings and diversity around the volunteer sites and the people on site.

On this masonry renovation site, you will participate in the reconstruction of the site ravaged by storm Alex in 2021. The mining site suffered the full force of this storm. The consequences were numerous, between material damage and impacts on the functioning of the structure. Since 2021, the association has done everything it can to rehabilitate the site in conjunction with the town of Tende, the Mercantour National Park and various local stakeholders.

WORK

Together we will build a storage room, built in stone. There already exists at this location an old slab and a retaining wall on which the building that we are going to construct will rest. Your mission will be to take this slab and start the foundations of the storage room. The reconstruction is planned in local stone, using the same method as all the buildings on the site. The objective is for the building to be in harmony with the whole. There will be 4 working days per week, from 8:30 a.m. to 12 p.m. and from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. This work does not require any particular skills and will be supervised by a technical supervisor.

Location: The hamlet of the Vallauria mine is located at an altitude of 1500 metres. The site is a 3-hour walk from the mythical Valley of Wonders, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

The inhabitants of this village in Haute-Saône are looking forward to welcoming their second international workcamp. It corresponds to the UN mission of "sustainable cities and communities" and its goals. This includes discovering new and different ways of thinking and acting, sharing skills, investing oneself to develop an area and taking part in the collective life: there will be many possibilities to promote solidarity! Each workcamp offers unique experiences, so come to Vellexon and make your own!

WORK

The community of Vellexon would like to establish a space for social connections in the heart of their town. To make it possible, this year we're continuing with the creation of a place that should soon host exchanges focused on solidarity and intergenerational links. To contribute to this development, you will be renovating the paving (floor) of the wash-house which is located next to this square for around 6 hours per day. You will learn techniques of traditional masonry (wall-building). There is no knowledge required! You will evolve as a team with the help of two leaders, sharing all tasks associated with collective life such as, cooking, cleaning, after work activities, etc.

Showers and laundry will be done in the homes of the locals. The worksite is only three minutes away by foot and for other trips like going shopping or visiting the surroundings, the locals will be gladly willing to help out.

Accompanied by the camp leaders, you will make the menu and prepare the meals each day, in turn. The budget is approx. 5€ per day and person. There will be the possibility to eat vegetarian or vegan and plan accordingly, if necessary. Often you will share meals with the villagers giving you the opportunity to discover the local gastronomy and to share special moments together.

LEISURE ACTIVITIES

May it be during the afternoons or the weekends, it will be your group that initiates and organizes the activities for the free time. The ideal programme will take into account the wishes of everybody, the local possibilities (hikes, local artists, summer concerts, "châteaux", etc) and the financial side of things.





LET'S BUILD THE HIKERS' SHELTER!

PROJECT

A small valley in the heart of a sublime alpine landscape, the remains of the 12th-century abbey of Clausonne, and a 300 km hiking trail. All this invites you to discover this rural area and its history! Here, for the past 30 years, a local association has been involved in preserving and promoting the site, as well as contributing to the life of Clausonne and writing its present-day history.

Last summer, work began on the construction of a hiker's shelter on the site. As this is a stage on an itinerary of ancient transhumance routes, you'll be contributing to welcoming cyclists and hikers for years to come.

This project is just one of the many initiatives in which international and local volunteers, the people on work integration programs and other professionals have participated over the years.

You'll be staying at the Ferme du Faï, an old mountain farmhouse that's kept alive by a team of employees working on the renovation of the buildings, artists and musicians in artistic residence, hikers passing through and the curious. Roll up your sleeves and join us onsite and in our collective living space!

WORK

You'll be working on a timber frame for a hiking shelter, located in the immediate proximity of the Abbey of Clausonne. A local carpenter will guide you in assembling the supporting structure, making the joints and building the floor. Each day, two members of the group will rotate in preparing meals for the team; the menu will be defined in advance. You'll work on-site during the mornings from Monday to Friday.

Generally speaking, the work involves carpentry, preparing tools and meals, as well as organizing and setting up community life.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

We will host you at the Faï FermeFaï, a welcoming site located at an altitude of 1000 meters. You will be accommodated in individual tents. A kitchen, dry toilets, and showers will be at your disposal at the site.

Here, we take care with our food to reduce our environmental impact: we eat local as much as possible and reduce our meat consumption to twice a week.

Daily life is organized collectively: menus (vegetarian, vegan diets, etc.), shopping, activities, and so on.

Location: The Clausonne site is a 20-minute walk from Ferme du Faï. Le Faï is 2 km from the village of Le Saix and 13 km from the town of Veynes. There's no Wi-Fi, so the connection is weak, but you'll meet people from all over the world!

SJ30 PRESERVING THE HÔTELLERIE STONE WALL

les Villages Jeunes

PROJECT

At the heart of an impressive mountain cirque in the French Alps, the hamlet of Vaunières sits on a vast, gently sloping plain. Large stone buildings nestled between meadows and forests... But this village is not like the others! Purchased as a ruin in the 60s by the Les Villages des Jeunes association, the site is now completely renewed, bustling with life thanks to the many events that take place here and the many local and international connections. Vaunières is a place to meet, to work; to enjoy the peace of the mountains, and the dynamism of the area. Today, the site lives and breathes thanks to a team of employees working on the maintenance of the site, volunteers, tourists, hikers, and aficionados. Roll up your sleeves and join us on-site and in our collective life spaces.



You will be working on the preservation of the south facade of the Hôtellerie building, in the hamlet of Vaunières. This stone façade is currently covered with a layer of insulation and a really damaged finish. The first phase of work will therefore involve removing the insulation to reveal the ancient masonry. Next, you will repoint the stones with mortar, and then apply the bonding plaster. A local expert will guide you through the various phases of the project. Some activities involve working on scaffolding. Each day, two members of the group will take turns preparing meals for the team; the menu will be defined in advance. You'll work on-site during the morning, Monday to Friday.

Generally speaking, the work involves masonry, preparing tools and meals, as well as organizing and setting up collective life.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

We welcome you to the hamlet of the Vaunières, at an altitude of 1170 meters. You'll be accommodated in dormitories with sanitary facilities, kitchen, and dining facilities at your disposal. Here, we pay close attention to our diet to reduce our environmental impact: we eat locally as much as possible and reduce our meat consumption to twice a week. Daily life is organized collectively: menus (vegetarian, vegan diets, etc.), shopping, activities, and so on. Once or twice for weeks, we organize shopping trips using the vehicles provided on site.

Location: The hamlet of Vaunières is 6km from Saint Julien en Beauchêne village and 23km from the nearby town of Veynes. There's no Wi-Fi, and the connection is weak, but you'll meet people from all over the world!

This commune is a long-standing partner of the association, with whom we carried out the first workcamps in the Charente-Maritime region in 1996. After a ten-year hiatus in projects in the area, in 2019 the municipality wanted to rekindle the intercultural momentum generated by the work camps, and in particular to use them to renovate the cemetery walls last year.

WORK

The aim of this project is to rebuild the perimeter wall of the former priory, located behind the school and alongside the stream. The work will involve restoring and consolidating this structure to ensure its solidity, while ensuring that it blends harmoniously into the surrounding landscape. As well as helping to preserve the local heritage, the project will give volunteers an opportunity to learn traditional masonry techniques, such as cutting and assembling stones, repointing and laying mortar. You don't need any qualifications to take part, just your enthusiasm and desire to learn. You will be supervised by experienced professionals who will guide you through the various stages of the work. Don't forget to bring suitable, comfortable, and hard-wearing clothing, as there is a risk that your clothes will be damaged or soiled. All the necessary safety equipment will be provided.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

You will sleep in La maison Bibard, a house recently acquired by the municipality. Participants will sleep in 3 areas equipped with mattresses. The house has all amenities (toilets, kitchens, etc.), but showers will be taken at the nearby gym (100m). You must bring your own duvet and pillow. Bicycles are available for use during the project. Food will be provided for breakfast, lunch and dinner. Meals will be prepared, in turn, by you, especially for lunch and dinner, while respecting environmental values and local resources, as well as everyone's culture (hot and cold dishes as well as vegetarian and vegan dishes will be prepared).

LEISURE ACTIVITIES

The aim will be to share your cultural wealth with the residents and associations of Saint-Genis-De-Saintonge. Visits to the region will be organised collectively according to your wishes (visits, ocean, museums, etc.). You can discover local towns such as St Emilion, Bordeaux, La Rochelle, etc. Leisure activities and local events will give you the chance to meet the locals!

PROJECT

A small valley in the heart of a sublime landscape, a sound system that makes the mountain resound with its echoes, people from the four corners of the world work side by side and experience international encounters on concrete tasks. Where?

Come to discover the unusual place of the Faï farm: an old mountain farmhouse that lives on today thanks to a team of employees working on renovating the site's buildings, artists and musicians in artistic residences, hikers passing through, and aficionados. For several years now, we have been working on renovating the Farmhouse building with thick hemp-lime insulation and natural-pigmented plaster on the exterior.

We're in the final stages of renovation, so come and help us complete the project!



You'll be working on finalizing the lime-hemp insulation of the facade, renovating the original staircase leading up to the side, and building the wooden balcony floor. You will also help us maintain the site's outdoor spaces by renovating the farmhouse. A local expert will guide you through the various phases of the work. Some activities involve working on scaffolding. Each day, two members of the group will take turns preparing meals for the team; the menu will be defined in advance. You will work on construction sites during the mornings from Monday to Friday. Generally speaking, the work involves masonry, preparing tools and meals, as well as organizing and setting up collective life.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

We host you at La Ferme du Faï, at an altitude of 1,000 meters. You will be accommodated in individual tents. A kitchen, dry toilets, and showers will be at your disposal on the site.

Here, we take care with our food to reduce our environmental impact: we eat local as much as possible and reduce our meat consumption to twice a week.

Daily life is organized collectively: menus (vegetarian, vegan diets, etc.), shopping, activities, and so on. Once or twice for weeks, we organize shopping trips using the vehicles provided on-site.

Location: Le Faï farm is 2 km from the village of Le Saix and 13 km from the town of Veynes. There's no Wi-Fi, so the connection is weak, but you'll meet people from all over the world!

PROJECT

For many years, the commune of Melle has been working hard to protect the environment. It is therefore committed to safeguarding and promoting biodiversity. This year, it is focusing its efforts on the Étang de la Craie, where you will be taking care of this exceptional wetland.

WORK

You'll be working to protect the local flora and fauna while enjoying a unique experience combining nature and culture. From 15th to 17th July, you'll be helping to set up the Jazz Festival, and then spending the rest of your stay taking part in ecological actions at the RBC (Municipal Biodiversity Reserve) de la Craie (2.5 km from the campsite). On the programme: creation and restoration of ponds, development of a mudflat, installation of wildlife shelters (nest boxes, bat houses, perches). Your commitment will contribute directly to preserving an ecosystem rich in amphibians, dragonflies, birds and bats.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

You will sleep in tents for 1 or 2 persons at the Melle municipal campsite. Mattresses will be provided. You must bring your own duvet and pillow. A Tivoli (large arbour) will be available with all amenities (fridge, gas cooker, cooking utensils, etc.). You will have a vehicle at your disposal for any mobility in the region. Food will be provided for breakfast, lunch and dinner (you will have a food budget which the leaders will manage and communicate with you throughout the work camp). Meals will be prepared in turn by you, especially for lunch and dinner, while respecting environmental values and local resources, as well as everyone's culture (hot and cold dishes as well as vegetarian and vegan dishes will be prepared).

LEISURE ACTIVITIES

AT THE HEART OF THE CHURCH 2

PROJECT

Not far from Poitiers, between the sky and the earth, in this commune called Buxerolles, an ancient church first mentioned in 1226, the Saint-Jacques-et-Saint-Philippe de Buxerolles church dates back to the Romanesque period. A first chapel, completely destroyed when the building was rebuilt in 1868, dates back to the 11th century. After several years, the building is in need of a facelift, and the project will involve refurbishing the church as well as intercultural sharing between locals and peace-building volunteers.



After two years spent restoring the interior walls of the church, the aim of this project is to continue renovating the walls of the Saint–Jacques–et–Saint–Philippe church in Buxerolles. The church dates back to the 11th century, but the walls have been plastered with cement, which has led to poor drainage of moisture and created saltpetre. Accompanied by a specialist technical supervisor, you will first have to remove the plaster from the walls, then dehumidify the walls, and finish by plastering them with lime. Other traditional masonry work will give you a chance to familiarise yourself with these techniques. Come with work clothes or clothes that may be damaged or soiled. We will provide you with safety equipment. No qualifications are required for this project. You will work 4 to 5 hours a day.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

You will sleep on mattresses at the Espace Marcel Varliette, where all facilities are available (toilets, kitchens, showers, common room, etc.). The church is located in the same place as the accommodation. You must bring your own duvet and pillow, and we'll provide inflatable mattresses. Meals, especially lunch and dinner, will be prepared by participants on a rotating basis, ensuring respect for environmental values, local resources, and everyone's cultural preferences. Both hot and cold dishes, as well as vegetarian and vegan options, will be included.

LEISURE ACTIVITIES





You will have the honor of being the first international volunteers to enter this building, which has been partially closed to the public for many years.


Under the supervision of a specialized technical instructor, you will begin by removing the wall plaster. You will then clear out the old mortar and repoint the stones to highlight their beauty. This will be a great opportunity to learn traditional masonry techniques, as well as ceiling work and insulation installation. Bring appropriate work clothing, as it may get dirty. Safety equipment will be provided, and no prior qualifications are required. You will work approximately 4 to 5 hours per day.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

Accommodation will be in one or two-person tents at the René Roux sports complex, where you will have exclusive access to the locker rooms for showers. You must bring your warm sleeping bag and a pillow; we provide inflatable mattresses. Food will be provided for all meals, with a budget managed collectively by the group and the facilitators. In turn, you will prepare meals, prioritizing local resources and respecting everyone's dietary regimes (hot and cold dishes, vegetarian, and vegan).

LEISURE ACTIVITIES

On the Île d'Oléron, you can enjoy many water activities, such as fishing and surfing with local clubs. The beach, bike rides along the coast, beach volleyball, and other pleasures await you. You can also visit cities like La Rochelle and Rochefort. Activities and outings will be organized with the local population and especially with youth organisations. Leisure time will encourage meeting the locals who are eagerly awaiting you!

BETVEEN PATHS & ENCOUNTERS

This project is not just about collective renovation work; it aims to foster intercultural encounters within this small village, where the locals eagerly await the arrival of the international workcamp every year. Aligned with the UN's goals for "sustainable cities and communities," it paves the way for numerous initiatives. Participating in this project offers the chance to actively engage with the area, explore new ways of thinking and acting, all while sharing your skills in a friendly atmosphere. Every workcamp is a unique adventure, and we invite you to experience yours!

WORK

Just a short walk from the village, at the edge of a forest, lies a picturesque setting where you will work for about 6 hours a day. The goal of this workcamp is to rebuild a wall that is at risk of collapsing. This task is essential for enhancing and securing this site, which has tourist potential. You will learn traditional dry stone masonry techniques. No prior experience is required! You will work as a team and also participate in daily collective tasks, such as cooking, cleaning, dishwashing, and activities with the local population.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

You will be accommodated in a mixed-gender large shared tent for eight people, where bunk beds with mattresses will be set up. You will also have access to a communal building with a new kitchen. Showers and washing machines will be available at the locals' homes, who always show great hospitality! However, a shower in the communal building is available at any time. Wi-Fi is available at the municipal building, which is just a short walk from the campsite. You will only need to bring your sleeping bag and pillow.

A 15-minute walk through the forest will be necessary to reach the worksite, where dry toilets will be specially installed. For other transportation, the local residents will be happy to help with shopping or guide you on visits to nearby areas.

Accompanied by the leaders, you will prepare the menus based on a budget (around 5€ per day per person) and take turns cooking daily meals. Vegetarian/vegan options will be available. In this village, you will be invited several times to eat at the locals' homes, another way to discover regional culinary specialties while sharing special moments together.

Location: The commune of Dampvalley-lès-Colombe (70000) is located 10 km from Vesoul in Haute-Saône.

Closest train station: Vesoul (70000)

Closest airports: Basel or the ones in Paris: Orly and Charles de Gaulle

With your feet in the water, you'll be helping to renovate the mills on the Sèvre Niortaise river, which date back to the 12th century. For many years, this river powered the mills in the villages of Sainte-Néomaye, Saint-Martin-de-Saint-Maixent and La Crèche. Today, these mills are an integral part of the local historical heritage. This project is being carried out in partnership with the "Association Syndicale Libre des Riverains de la Sèvre Niortaise", which manages the hydraulic activity of 25 mills and supports the owners in preserving their natural heritage. This project will give you the chance to contribute to the enhancement of this ancient heritage, while working in the heart of an exceptional natural setting.



To the sound of the murmur of water, you will take part in the maintenance and restoration of the structures of 3 mills on the Sèvre Niortaise river, in the communes of Sainte-Néomaye, Saint-Martin de Saint-Maixent, and La Crèche. You'll be repairing bank walls, restoring a footbridge and clearing a water passage. Some traditional masonry techniques, such as working with hydrated lime and clay, will be taught to you by a specialist technical supervisor. You will be supervised and accompanied by the owners of the mills throughout the work. You will also be able to learn about certain hydraulic systems.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

Accommodation will be in tents for one or two people, at the Saint-Maixent municipal campsite (79400). You will need to bring your own warm duvet and pillow, and we will provide inflatable mattresses. Food will be provided for all meals, with a budget managed collectively by the group and the leaders. You will take it in turns to prepare the meals, using local resources and respecting everyone's dietary requirements (hot, cold, vegetarian and vegan dishes).

LEISURE ACTIVITIES

At the crossroads of some pretty little villages in the Deux-Sèvres, you can make the most of the local heritage. Visits to the region will be organised collectively according to your wishes, for example the silver mines of the kings of France, the cinema, the municipal swimming pool, etc. You can also discover local towns such as Niort and Celles-sur-Belle. Leisure time and local activities will encourage you to meet the locals!

Accompanied by a professional, you will begin by assessing the condition of the structures before renovating or replacing the most damaged elements. No specific skills are required: you'll learn how to sand, strip, protect the wood, measure and change the boards that make up these bridges. It's a great opportunity to develop your skills while contributing to a useful and sustainable project!

Accommodation will be in tents for one or two people, near the municipal stadium. You must bring your own warm duvet and pillow, and we will provide inflatable mattresses. You will have access to changing rooms for showers and meal preparation. You will be 800 metres from the site.

Food will be provided for breakfast, lunch and dinner (you will have a food budget which the leaders will manage and communicate with you throughout the work camp). Meals, especially lunch and dinner, will be prepared by participants on a rotating basis, ensuring respect for environmental values, local resources, and everyone's cultural preferences. Today, the site lives and breathes thanks to a team of employees working at the maintenance of the site, volunteers, tourists, hikers, and aficionados. Roll up your sleeves and join us on-site and in our collective life spaces.

WORK

You will be working on the maintenance of camping areas in the hamlet of Vaunières. You will be involved in clearing brush and landscaping, as well as dismantling and storing the wooden components of a yurt. A local expert will guide you through the various tasks. Each day, two members of the group will take turns preparing meals for the team; the menu will be defined in advance. You will work on-site during the mornings from Monday to Friday.

Generally speaking, the work involves carpentry, preparing tools and meals, as well as organizing and setting up collective life.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD


We host you in the Vaunières hamlet, at an altitude of 1170 meters. You will be accommodated in individual tents, kitchen, dry toilets, and showers will be at your disposal.

Here, we pay close attention to our diet to reduce our environmental impact: we eat locally as much as possible and reduce our meat consumption to twice a week. Daily life is organized collectively: menus (vegetarian, vegan diets, etc.), shopping, activities, and so on. Once or twice per week, we organize shopping trips using the vehicles provided on-site.

LEISURE ACTIVITIES

You will be in an exceptional location to discover the pleasures of hiking in the mountains, wandering near rivers and lakes, enjoying local markets, and festive evenings organized in the surrounding villages (according to the program). THE SILVER MINE OF THE MERCANTOUR PARC

17/08 - 30/08 ARCH/CONS 12 vols 18+

PROJECT

The Neige & Merveilles association welcomes you to the heart of the Mercantour National Park at an altitude of 1,500 m to work in the Vallauria mine, which is part of the archaeological, historical and scientific heritage of the Alpes Maritimes. This silver lead and zinc mine justifies the mining archeology studies and the conservation and development work that we have been carrying out with the municipality of Tende for around ten years. Its medieval part represents an exceptional geological heritage, inseparable from that represented by the Mercantour park and the archaeological riches of the mythical Vallée des Merveilles, a soon to be classified UNESCO site, located a two-hour walk away.



Together we will continue to expand the mine tour route. The aim of this project is to highlight the discharge chimney, which allowed the dumping of fill into the wagons, at the time when the mine was still exploited (from the medieval period until the 20th century). To do this, there will first be the removal of backfill at the top of the chimney which will be followed by the construction of a dry stone wall to support the vaults. Secondly, we will build a small stone staircase. There will be 4 working days per week, from 8:30 a.m. to 12 p.m. and from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. This work does not require any particular skills and will be supervised by a technical supervisor.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

The accommodation is located on the construction site. You will be accommodated in dormitory rooms with 4 to 6 beds equipped with mattresses, pillows and bathroom facilities. Please bring your sleeping bag. You will participate in the collective and daily life of the group and the place. Food is provided in the budget, and meals will be prepared by you in turn, accompanied by the group life facilitator and in a kitchen with all the necessary equipment. You will participate in cleaning dishes and tidying up dining areas and the kitchen. Specific foods may be requested in order to cook typical dishes from each country or region. 
The Neige & Merveilles association welcomes you to the heart of the Mercantour National Park at an altitude of 1500 m, to work on the continuation of the Vallauria mining hamlet development project. You will discover an exceptional geological heritage and take part in a human and collective adventure which has lasted for more than 60 years. The Neige et Merveilles association has been working since its creation to revive this historic site in order to offer a haven of peace promoting discovery, meetings and diversity around the volunteer sites and the people on site. The purpose of this project lies in the development of a neighboring terrace at the starting point for visits to the mine, located just above the hamlet.



Your mission will be to install wooden barriers to secure the terrace. Located near one of the mine entrances used by the miners, we will use part of this space to experiment with slaughter by fire for visitors, a technique used since the dawn of time before the arrival of dynamite, which consists of strongly heating the working face using a pyre to cause a thermal shock which will flake the surface of the rock. It is a technique that characterizes the medieval mine of Vallauria. There will be 4 working days per week, from 8:30 a.m. to 12 p.m. and from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. This work does not require any particular skills and will be supervised by a technical supervisor.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

The accommodation is located on the construction site. You will be accommodated in dormitory rooms with 4 to 6 beds equipped with mattresses, pillows, and bathroom facilities. Please bring your sleeping bag. You will participate in the collective and daily life of the group and the place. Montendre is home to one of Solidarités Jeunesses' international centres, the Maison des Bateleurs. The commune of Montendre has been running an international workcamp every year for over 10 years, focusing in particular on its castle. This year, however, the municipality decided to focus the workcamp on renovating the barn lean-to of the house.

WORK

The aim of this project is to renovate the roof of the "Bateleur". This is the lean-to building adjoining the reception centre barn. Under the guidance of the local authority's technical staff, you'll be removing the existing lean-to and carrying out the necessary repairs to the roof structure, then laying the new tiles. No special skills are required, but the work site will be at height and access will be via scaffolding (installed by the municipal services prior to the work site).

WORK

This year, you will be working on the continuation of maintenance work on the casemates (fortified shelters) at Fort Vauban. Accompanied by a specialist technical supervisor, you will initially be responsible for removing vegetation from the structure, then disjointing and repointing with lime mortar. Next, you will take part in transforming the museum's former storeroom into an educational room. You'll learn how to fit plasterboard panels and finish painting.

You'll learn a range of techniques, including traditional masonry, plastering and painting.



The Château de Bruzac has been a co-castle for centuries. Indeed, since the 13th century, it has been the seat of a co-lordship following a complicated succession. So complex that until the revolution, it remained separated into two sets of habitats within the same fortified enclosure despite the various occupations, wars and revolts. After the revolution and the evictions of the noble families of the site, the castle will serve as a quarry for the inhabitants of the village of Saint Pierre de Côle and the surrounding farms.

For around thirty years, it has belonged to a couple of history enthusiasts and is managed and promoted by the local association "Renaissance du Vieux Bruzac". You'll have the chance to help them clear the chapel and salvage the stones. These 2 weeks of work will be punctuated by the European Heritage Days on 20 and 21 September. You'll be taking a step back in time, and on this occasion, you'll be helping to welcome visitors in a medieval setting, with costumed activities.

You'll also have the chance to find out from this association, which is passionate about history, how people cooked in the Middle Ages and during the Renaissance, and to visit the Dordogne, a land of gastronomy and history.

WORK

You will participate in the continuation of work at the castle, in particular consolidation of the lime walls, clearing undergrowth and cleaning different parts of the site. You will also take care of the various plantations in the medieval garden built on previous sites. On the last weekend, you will take part in the world days at Heritage Days and welcome visitors to the château.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

You will be welcomed in bungalows with 3/4 places in a campsite near Thiviers. A covered dining area is reserved for you, with a kitchen where you can take turns preparing tasty dishes. PROJECT

This international workcamp is organized in partnership with the Syndicat mixte Rivage and the commune of Le Barcarès, on the edge of the Etang de Salses Leucate, a protected wetland renowned for its varied biodiversity. The partnership between the Rivage syndicat mixte and the REV has existed for several years. The syndicate regularly collaborates with REV on the organization of international workcamps and other one-off events. The two organizations are used to working together, and share the same values and ambitions. In addition to removing invasive species (witch's claw, yucca, prickly pear, agave, etc.), the aim of this year's workcamp will be to help set up measures to protect and enhance the site's existing biodiversity (e.g. trail development). As the work is weather-related, tasks are generally defined at the start of the project.

WORK

This workcamp will enable you to carry out a number of activities: opening up the environment (cutting down trees), delimiting the protected area from the area frequented by kitesurfers, for example (installing wooden barriers), uprooting invasive species to enable endemic species (flora or fauna) to reproduce. The aim of the project is to preserve the area around the pond, whether through visitor management or plant management. 25h/week

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

You'll be staying in a gîte provided by the local council, just a few minutes from the Mediterranean Sea. There are dormitories, sanitary facilities, and a kitchen. Meals will be provided and prepared in turn by participants.

LEISURE ACTIVITIES

As the workcamp will take place in a protected area, most leisure activities will involve discovering the surrounding nature (flora and fauna), as well as the culinary heritage. Transportation will also be provided to organize discovery outings and leisure activities.

PROJECT

In association with the AFPL (Association Foncière Pastorale Libre), you will take part in an international workcamp in the commune of Saint-Michel-de-Dèze. The aim is to rehabilitate part of the commune's agricultural land, to enable winegrowers to set up and produce wine. Through this project, you are enabling the commune, the AFPL and the winegrowers to move forward with the project to re-establish a vineyard in the high Cévennes. The worksite will take place during the vinification of the first harvests, so you can also learn about the wine-making process. The aim of this project is to promote local know-how and contribute to the rehabilitation of agricultural land abandoned at the end of the 19th century during the rural exodus.



The work will involve firstly clearing vegetation to clear structures covered by it and secondly repairing damaged structures (stone terraces). You'll also help with the installation of trellises and any other actions that will encourage the cultivation of vines on the vineyard terraces. The expected work time is 25 hours per week.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

You'll be welcomed at the "Le Verdier" gîte, located a few kilometers from the worksite. This gîte has been set up in a renovated ruin, transformed into typical, modern Cévenol accommodation. Meals will be provided and prepared in turn by participants.

LEISURE ACTIVITIES

Nestled in the hollow of a green valley, the town of Coly - St Amand is located in the heart of the Périgord Noir, a territory rich in history! Composed of two former municipalities that have decided to unite into one, we will work to unite these formerly separate territories into one.

The Ecocycle association is a third place which develops a participatory animation project on the territory of the municipality of Saint Amand de Coly and its surroundings. These activities are strongly influenced by concerns related to climate change. In this context you will participate in the design and preparation of a shared garden.

You will discover the sense of hospitality of the population and the charm of the landscapes and the heritage, by organizing with the other volunteers, and the animators your program of activities.

WORK

You will have the opportunity to be introduced to the concept of permaculture and agroforestry. ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD



PROJECT

Come to discover one of the small perched towns in France's Southern Alps! The town of Serres, which backs onto the Pignolette rock, comprises narrow medieval streets, covered passageways, and steep slopes. That makes it a pleasant place to wander. In this context, we invite you to participate in a project to restore an old shortcut in the historic center. For several years now, in partnership with the commune of Serres, the association Les Villages des Jeunes has been working to bring the town's narrow medieval streets to life, maintain and valorize them. The various projects we organize on this site aim to enhance and consolidate these unusual urban passages while enriching their history through the intercultural exchanges typical of international workcamps.



WORK

You'll be working on the consolidation of a stone stairway in the historic center of the small town of Serres. After a preliminary clearing of the site, you'll work on consolidating the stone steps and creating a dry-stone border on the side.

A local expert will guide you in the staircase maintenance, the choice of stones, and their correct positions. Each day, two members of the group will rotate to prepare meals for the team; the menu will be defined in advance. You'll work on-site during the mornings from Monday to Friday.

PROJECT

Ready to be part of a collaborative adventure? Join us in preparing Les Nuits Guépiennes, a vibrant festival that brings together 2000 people every year along the Viaur River. Get involved behind the scenes and work alongside the dedicated volunteer team of les P'Tite Lumière and Cie to help build and shape this exciting event. Your energy and enthusiasm will make all the difference!

You will also discover the values of the CITRUS association, its operating methods as an international welcoming place that promotes living together, sharing, and diversity. It's a real little haven of peace.

Guided by our supervising team, you'll experience life in the heart of the association, sharing daily life with the Citrus team, international volunteers, and local volunteers from the Guépienne association.

WORK

As part of this project, you will participate in morning work sessions to build a wooden movable bar several meters long. With Rémi, a local carpenter-joiner, who will be your technical supervisor for these two weeks, you'll learn woodworking and gradually create this key piece, which is essential for the festival. You'll also work on building a welcoming wooden arch, which will help greet visitors and festival goers who come every summer to participate in the iconic Les Nuits Guépiennes festival in Laguépie. This festival, which takes place in July and August, celebrates poetry, literature, music, and the arts in general.

If you have some free mornings, you will also create signage to be installed in the village and along the Viaur river, where artists perform.

All of this will be done with professional help and supervision. No prior skills required, only the motivation to learn!

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

You will be accommodated at the CITRUS association's site in shared tents (8-12 people) with floors and beds. There are beautiful composting toilets and solar showers, all built by former workcamps participants. A washing machine is available for reasonable and regulated use. There is no Wi-Fi connection.

You will participate daily in maintaining the site and preparing meals. Collective decisions will ensure a balanced diet based on your tastes, dietary requirements, and seasonal local products. Cooking is part of the project, just like the construction activities.

WORK



You'll be staying at the Ferme du Faï, an old mountain farmhouse that's kept alive by a team of employees working on the renovation of the buildings, artists and musicians in artistic residences, hikers passing through, and the curious. Roll up your sleeves and join us on-site and in our collective living space!

WORK


You'll be working on a timber frame for a hiking shelter, located in the immediate proximity of the Abbey of Clausonne. A local carpenter will guide you in assembling the supporting structure, making the joints, and building the floor. Each day, two members of the group will rotate in preparing meals for the team; the menu will be defined in advance. You'll work on-site during the mornings from Monday to Friday.

PROJECT

The aim of the workcamp is to build a sauna, a leisure and relaxation facility, close to the Finiels colony, which welcomes volunteers from the REV - Réseau d'entraide volontaire workcamps every year. Building a sauna on the site of the volunteer workcamp serves a dual purpose. Firstly, the sauna, a Scandinavian tradition, is a convivial place where people can meet, chat, warm up and relax at the same time. As the hamlet of Finiels lies at an altitude of 1541m, summer nights can be chilly. Volunteers taking part in this project, as well as those who will follow, will be able to benefit from this infrastructure, which will make the summer evenings warmer, while at the same time helping to strengthen the bonds within the groups. TRACING THE STEPS OF THE DUKE OF LESDIGUIERES

11/07 - 25/07 **RENO 12 vols 18-30**

PROJECT

For 24 years, volunteers from all over the world have been working to preserve the remains of the Duc de Lesdiguières castle. Will you be the next to join the adventure?

Set in idyllic mountain scenery, this 16th-century château has been listed as a Historical Monument since 1978. In 2000, a local association was created to safeguard the building's historical, architectural, and cultural memory. The Duc de Lesdiquières - the building's illustrious patron - was the last Constable of France. This military figure is known for his involvement in the Wars of Religion, as well as for his commitment to the construction and development of roads, bridges, and dikes to prevent flooding in the region. He had this château built between 1571 and 1580, but after his death, it was abandoned and looted during the French Revolution. Nowadays the various works we are organizing on this site are designed to consolidate the ruins of this precious work of architecture while enriching its history through the intercultural encounters typical of international work camps.



You will be working on consolidating the masonry of a stone parapet wall in the castle ruins. You will restore the masonry on the first rows of stones. A local expert will guide you in the choice of stones to be used, their positioning, and the use of mortar. Some activities involve working on scaffolding. Each day, two members of the group will take turns preparing meals for the team; the menu will be defined in advance. You'll work on-site during the morning, Monday to Friday.



- removal of the level, extraction of old blockages over 20cm, purging of old mortar;
- creation of a solid "ruin-like" rockwork binding the two faces of the facing;
- prospecting of the outer lining to uncover archaeological material. The motivated team of "Les Veilleurs de Salm" will provide the technical supervision for this work.

You will be accommodated in a mixed-gender shared space in a large municipal building reserved for your group (maximum 14 people). Two rooms will serve as dormitories where you will sleep on camp beds. You only need to bring your sleeping bag and pillow. The place is equipped with a kitchen. Showers will be taken at the gymnasium of the village. A washing machine will also be available. Free Wi-Fi is available at the local tourist office, which is adjacent to your accommodation.

Come and have fun in the village of Orpierre, world-famous for its rock climbing!

Set in a remarkable natural environment, the village stands between an impressive cliff and the Céans River. Opposite the village, in the valley on the other bank of the river, you'll find the gardens, a natural space where you can relax and cool off in summer.

Here, the vigor of the tree roots, time, and the weather have cleared away the dry-stone wall characteristic of this site. Would you like to join us in putting everything back in place? We're going to learn and experiment with the traditional dry-stone construction technique. For several years now, in partnership with the commune of Orpierre, the association Les Villages des Jeunes has been working to bring to life, maintain, and promote drystone work in the area through international work camps.

WORK

The work begins with clearing the site of brushwood, carefully observing and reading the parts of the wall in the traditional way that are in good condition here. You'll then work on removing the remaining parts, enabling you to start reassembling the wall in the traditional dry-stone manner. A local expert will guide you in your choice of stones and teach you how to position them correctly on the wall. Each day, two members of the group will take turns preparing meals for the team; the menu will be defined in advance. You'll work on the sites during the mornings from Monday to Friday.

Generally speaking, the work involves dry stone, preparing tools and meals, as well as organizing and setting up collective life.



Generally speaking, the work involves masonry, preparing tools and meals, as well as organizing and setting up collective life.



Vir'Volt also aims to become fully eco-friendly and sustainable, which is reflected in our campsite: yurts and teepees as rooms, permaculture farming and gardening, water-saving projects, reducing and reusing waste. This small village will become great without sacrificing or damaging the surrounding environment whilst always searching for better and more eco-friendly ways of living.



During this Workcamp, you will be working on various projects at the association's site alongside international and local volunteers. You'll help develop the eco-village by building wooden furniture (pallets and simple woodworking), creating compost bins for outdoor spaces, and setting up the solar shower on site. This winter project will be a challenge since it takes place outdoors in unheated areas and under winter conditions (cold and windy). However, you'll feel great knowing you're actively contributing to the construction of a unique eco-village and leaving your mark!

PROJECT

Not far from Poitiers, between sky and earth, in this commune called Buxerolles, an ancient church first mentioned in 1226, the Saint-Jacques-et-Saint-Philippe de Buxerolles church dates back to the Romanesque period. A first chapel, completely destroyed when the building was rebuilt in 1868, dates back to the 11th century. After several years, the building is in need of a facelift, and the project will involve restoring the church as well as intercultural sharing between locals and peace-building volunteers.

WORK

After two years spent restoring the interior walls of the church, the aim of this project is to continue renovating the walls of the Saint-Jacques-et-Saint-Philippe church in Buxerolles. The church dates back to the 11th century, but the walls have been plastered with cement, which has led to poor moisture drainage and created saltpetre. Accompanied by a specialist technical supervisor, you will first have to remove the plaster from the walls, then dehumidify the walls and finish by plastering them with lime. Other traditional masonry work will give you a chance to familiarise yourself with these techniques. Come with work clothes or clothes that may be damaged or soiled. We will provide you with safety equipment. No qualifications are required for this project. You will work 4 to 5 hours a day.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

You will sleep on mattresses in non-mixed areas at the Espace Marcel Varliette, where all facilities are available (toilets, kitchens, showers, common room, etc.). The church is located in the same place as the accommodation. You'll need to bring your own duvet and pillow, and we'll provide inflatable mattresses. Meals, especially lunch and dinner, will be prepared by participants on a rotating basis, ensuring respect for environmental values, local resources, and everyone's cultural preferences. Both hot and cold dishes, as well as vegetarian and vegan options, will be included.


PROJECT

At the heart of an impressive mountain cirque in the French Alps, the hamlet of Vaunières sits on a vast, gently sloping plain. Large stone buildings nestled between meadows and forests... But this village is not like the others! Purchased as a ruin in the 60s by the Les Villages des Jeunes association, the site is now completely renewed, bustling with life thanks to the many events that take place here and the many local and international connections. Vaunières is a place to meet, to work; to enjoy the peace of the mountains, and the dynamism of the area. Today, the site lives and breathes thanks to a team of employees working on the maintenance of the site, volunteers, tourists, hikers, and aficionados. Roll up your sleeves and join us on-site and in our collective life spaces.



You will be working on the preservation of the south facade of the Hôtellerie building, in the hamlet of Vaunières. This stone façade is currently covered with a layer of insulation and a really damaged finish. The first phase of work will therefore involve removing the insulation to reveal the ancient masonry. Next, you will repoint the stones with mortar, and then apply the bonding plaster. A local expert will guide you through the various phases of the project. Some activities involve working on scaffolding. Each day, two members of the group will take turns preparing meals for the team; the menu will be defined in advance. You'll work on-site during the morning, Monday to Friday.

Generally speaking, the work involves masonry, preparing tools and meals, as well as organizing and setting up community life.

SJ/TEEN52 HOW TO COAT 2.0

01/08 - 15/08 RENO/CONS 12 vols 15-17

PROJECT

The project involves making a natural rendering using lime and hemp. You'll learn how to prepare and mix materials (lime, hemp, sand and water) to apply a rendering to walls. The work will include finishing steps, such as coloring with natural pigments or smoothing surfaces for a smooth or textured appearance. You'll be actively involved in the creative process, while complying with safety instructions. The workcamp aims to raise awareness of ecological materials while developing practical and creative skills. This project is part of the renovation program for the association's new home.

WORK

You will learn how to prepare materials (lime, hemp, sand, water), mix them and apply plaster to the walls in several layers. Each phase of the work will be supervised to ensure that surfaces are well moistened before application and that drying times are respected between coats. Your group will be divided up to carry out the various stages: preparing the mixture, applying the plaster, finishing (smoothing, texturing or adding pigments). This project will enable you to develop teamwork skills and construction techniques, while applying safety practices (gloves, goggles). The progress of the project will be monitored by a technical supervisor to ensure that all the work is carried out efficiently and to a high standard. 20h/week

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

The workcamp will take place in a particularly isolated area, where you will be accommodated on the REV site in a collective tent (remember to bring your sleeping bag). You will have access to sanitary facilities close to the camp. What's more, if weather conditions deteriorate too much for camping, we'll set up a permanent camp for the duration of the bad weather. PROJECT

Sustainable development, particularly permaculture, is a core theme deeply embedded in the values of our association, and it is integrated into all our actions. This is why Maison des Bateleurs – Solidarités Jeunesses has been working for several years to create an environmental hub: a phytosanitary pond, dry toilets, composting, an organic garden, the use of local natural resources, to name just a few examples.

WORK

During this workcamp, you will actively participate in the life of the Maison and its various activities: collective living (cooking, cleaning, organization, etc.), intercultural exchanges (meeting with the local community and other volunteers from the association), etc.
