

FRANCO-SPANISH TRAINING ON INTERNATIONAL WORKCAMP LEADERSHIP

Cross-border cooperation in Occitanie and Catalonia



OBJECTIVES

- Train facilitators capable of leading international workcamps.
- Develop technical and educational skills suited to an intercultural context.
- Create facilitation tools that promote participation and inclusion.
- Encourage exchanges between French and Spanish stakeholders to strengthen cross-border cooperation.



PROGRAM

- Group dynamics and team functioning
- The role of a group life facilitator
- Educational approach to technical work
- Technical knowledge on dry-stone wall construction



METHODOLOGY

A participatory approach based on popular education. Use of graphic facilitation to enhance understanding. Experience-sharing and collective analysis. Hands-on field exercises.

TRAINING COORDINATION: Association Concordia

The Museum of Paths is a project dedicated to preserving the traditional trails of the Pyrenees, located in the Siarb Valley, in the Pallars Sobirà region. This network of trails, footbridges, small walls, and ancient constructions is restored and maintained by the local community and international volunteer groups.

La Couvertoirade is a medieval village located in the Grands Causses Regional Natural Park, in the Aveyron department of Occitanie. It is classified as one of the "Most Beautiful Villages in France" and is known for its well-preserved architecture, fortified walls, narrow streets, and stone houses. The association Les Amis de la Couvertoirade is actively involved in the conservation of this cultural heritage.



PRACTICAL INFORMATION

- A detailed itinerary will be sent upon confirmation of your registration.
- The training is free of charge, including accommodation and meals.
- Transportation is not covered, but carpooling options are available from Toulouse and Montpellier.
- The training program consists of two intensive workshop sessions per day, one in the morning and one in the afternoon.
- There will be no visits to nearby towns as part of the agenda.
