About the project



ARTIVISM IN ACTION

In today's world, social issues such as climate change, human rights, and inequality are becoming increasingly urgent, yet misinformation, stereotypes, and cultural differences often hinder meaningful discussions. At the same time, intercultural dialogue is essential for promoting understanding, inclusion, and collective action. The "Artivism for Change" youth exchange brings these two critical areas together, creating a space where young people can explore the power of art in addressing social challenges while fostering intercultural learning and collaboration for social justice.

This exchange will bring together 25 young participants from diverse cultural backgrounds, encouraging impactful conversations on social issues such as climate change, human rights, and equality, while exploring how art can be used as a tool for activism. Through non-formal education methods, participants will engage in interactive workshops, creative activities, collaborative art projects, and group discussions to develop skills in using art for social change, advocacy, and raising awareness on pressing global challenges.



TARGET GROUP

Young people 18-30, adult 18+ (for leader), volunteers and active members of the partner organisations



Ideally, we are looking for someone with a strong interest or background in the arts, who is passionate about social change and open to intercultural learning.

AIM & OBJECTIVES

- Raise awareness among young people about the power of art as a tool for activism and social change.
- Create a platform for young people from diverse cultural backgrounds to exchange their experiences, ideas, and art practices, fostering international cooperation in artivism.
- Strengthen the participants' ability to advocate for social change by empowering them with the tools to create their own artivist projects.
- Establish a supportive network of young artivists, mentors, and organizations that can collaborate on future initiatives.

YOUR JOURNEY TO THE VENUE


- You will arrive at Athens International Airport.

- A shuttle is organised for you, from Kiato station to the village Kryoneri where you will stay for the whole week.



HOW TO REACH KIATO TRAIN STATION



From the aiport take the **suburban train** with destination 'Peiraias – Πειραιάς'and get off at 'Kato Axarnai – **Κάτω Αχαρναί**' station.



From 'Kato Axarnai – **Κάτω Αχαρναί** ', change to the train on the near platrform (Line 1) going towards 'Kiato – **Κιάτο** ' and get off at 'Kiato Station'.
