- Young change-makers who are already involved in local or international youth projects, volunteering, student leadership, or social initiatives.

 through cultural dialogue and shared learning.

Background of C&Y Catalytic Pitching

The C&Y Catalytic Pitching echoes the theme "Thriving C&Y Conference." It amplifies youth and children's voices, emphasizing authentic intelligence.

Centered on "Making catalytic impact for a thriving future," it follows three core principles:

- 1. Equip youth with mindset and skills to express their voices.
- 2. Provide a platform to connect with like-minded stakeholders.
- 3. Empower them to actualize ideas, creating real change in daily life.

Connect & Co-create online (Mid-July)

Join online sessions to share your ideas and give feedback to help your Hong Kong team shape and strengthen their pitch.



Represent Global Voices (during the camp)

Bring your perspective and help create a more inclusive, cross-cultural impact story to support the Hong Kong pitching team to prepare for their presentation idea.

May - July: Selection and Preperation

We will recruit overseas
youth to join the camp,
followed by shortlisting
candidates for acceptance.
During this stage, we will also
share more information to
help with preparation.



Mid-July: Online Interaction & Idea Exchange

Connect with youth from worldwide, share and refine ideas through cross-cultural dialogue.*

Early August: Coaching Sessions

Enhance public speaking and pitching skills for groups.






Late August: C&Y Catalytic Pitching

Programme Fee: Free of Charge

A flight subsidy of up to USD 600 (depends on departure location) may be offered to outstanding delegates selected through the interview and selection process.

Submit Your Application

Complete the application form with your motivation and relevant background details.

Join Online Interaction (mid-July)

Engage in mid-July's idea exchange with Hong Kong youth teams.

Attend Pre-camp Briefing

Participate in the briefing session to prepare for the camp experience.

Flight Subsidy Distribution (Aug)

Receive your subsidy after completing online events and arriving in Hong Kong.
