Critical Eye Reading Digital Media Training Course

"Critical Eye Reading Media" is an international training program designed to empower youth workers, educators, and young leaders with the skills to navigate today's complex information landscape. Let's be real, we're drowning in content, overwhelmed by fake news, and pulled apart by divisive stories every day.

But here's the thing, you can do more than just get by in this media chaos, you can help change it for the better. This learning journey combines media literacy with practical peacebuilding strategies, providing you with how to build bridges with Peacebuilders, understand cultural differences in media, and use digital platforms to drive positive peace.

By the end of this program, you won't just be a savvier media consumer; you'll be equipped to help others see through the fog and use media as a tool for building more peaceful and inclusive communities.

What will you learn?

In "Critical Eye Reading Media," you'll gain essential skills to navigate today's digital landscape with confidence. You'll:


- Get the skills to look critically at what you're seeing across social media.
- Learn how to trace where content comes from and decide if it's trustworthy.
- Develop your "bias radar" to catch when content is pushing a particular viewpoint.
- Master the fundamental ideas that help you navigate today's complex information landscape.
- Discover what peacebuilding means and how it works in digital practice.
- Understand how the media can either fuel tensions or help resolve conflicts in troubled areas.







Methodological approach



This training is all about strengthening media literacy and equipping participants with the skills they need to navigate today's digital world confidently.

We'll use creative and engaging methods based on non-formal education, think hands-on learning, meaningful discussions, group work, and space for reflection. The focus is on empowering participants, encouraging critical thinking, and building practical skills that can be applied in real life.

While some parts of the training will use online tools, we'll also make space to unplug and recharge. With intentional digital detox moments in the beautiful natural surroundings of our accommodation, we aim to strike a healthy balance, combining meaningful learning with time to connect with nature and each other in a peaceful, inspiring setting.

Here's the draft agenda for the training course. Keep in mind that it's still subject to updates, we'll adjust it based on the learning needs of the participants that we gather from the application form. This means we'll tailor the course to better fit what participants are looking to learn, so the final agenda may look a bit different.

Who is this training for?

Our course is designed for:

- ★ **Digital Youth Workers** Professionals working with young people in digital spaces who want to sharpen their skills in digital journalism, peacebuilding, and creating inclusive online environments.
- ★ Media-Focused Change Makers People who support youth facing social, economic, or cultural barriers and want to help them navigate digital spaces more effectively.
- ★ Peace Advocates Activists and volunteers involved in peace initiatives who want to leverage digital tools and conscious media approaches.

To take part in the training, participants should:

- ★ Be **18 years** old or older
- ★ Live in one of these countries: Bulgaria, Estonia, France, Italy, North Macedonia, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Spain, or Turkey
- ★ Commit to join us for the **full training course**, from 26th July to 2nd August 2025
- ★ Commit to carrying out a follow-up activity in their local community after the training, putting their new skills and knowledge into practice
- ★ Feel comfortable communicating in **English**, as the training will be held in English
- ★ Be ready to get involved before the course too, this includes filling out a short questionnaire, sharing some relevant examples or materials from your organisation and joining an online prep meeting.

We encourage people from all walks of life, no matter their background, gender, or personal story. Our goal is to create a safe and inclusive space where everyone feels respected, supported, and free to learn, grow, and build their skills together.

Practical info

- 1. **Travel costs** Your travel costs will be reimbursed after the training course, based on the actual cost of your tickets—up to a set maximum amount per country. To receive the reimbursement, you'll need to:
 - a. Provide all original travel documents (tickets, boarding passes, invoices, etc.)
 - b. Submit them within the agreed timeframe after the training
 - c. Arrive and depart from the same location

2. Accommodation, The training will take place at a school dormitory with basic but comfortable living conditions. You will share a room with two other participants, and the bathroom facilities will be shared as well. The dormitory is located in Pniewy, near Poznań, easily accessible from Poznań Main Station and Poznań Airport by public transport.







3. **Food,** During the seminar, we'll provide three vegetarian meals a day with vegan options. This choice reflects SCI's strong commitment to sustainability and climate justice.
