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PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Youth Service Community (YSC) is a transformative program by the Cambodian Youth Action (CYA) designed to empower international volunteers to enhance primary education in rural Cambodia while working alongside Cambodian national volunteers.

Through the Primary Education Enhancement Project, you'll collaborate with Cambodian volunteers, local teachers, parents, and community members to complement existing educational efforts by filling gaps in literacy, English language skills, digital skills, school environment improvement, and school resources.



YSC builds on Cambodia's educational strengths, adding innovative approaches and global perspectives to create sustainable community impact while equipping you with skills and knowledge for your future career in fields like education, international development, or project management.

PROGRAM YSC international volunteers commit from 6 to 12 months in rural communities, including Kampot, Kampong Speu, FOCUS Battambang, and Siem Reap, working as a team with Cambodian national volunteers in the following areas:



Enhance Children Learning

Teach English and introduce digital literacy to students aged 6–12 using creative, interactive methods.



Collaborate with local teachers

Support lesson planning, codesign teaching materials, and share new strategies to make learning more engaging.



Engage Community

Facilitate meetings with parents, teachers, and local leaders to increase community involvement and reduce dropout rates.



Improve School Environment

Lead projects like painting murals, renovating classrooms, creating school gardens, and establishing reading spaces.



Learn & Lead with Global Peers

Work side by side with international and national YSC volunteers who join the same program through CYA. Together, you'll co-lead projects, share cultures, solve problems as a team, and strengthen global understanding.

WHAT WE EXPECT FROM YOU?

We seek committed, passionate international volunteers ready to enhance Cambodian communities while working collaboratively with national volunteers and leading short-term volunteer groups. Our expectations include:

Commitment



A minimum 6-month commitment (extendable up to 12 months) to ensure continuity for students and communities, as short-term volunteering can disrupt learning.

- Recent graduate (within 2 years) from a Cambodian university or vocational program.
- Aged 18-35 years.

Eligibility Basic English proficiency to support teaching and collaboration with international volunteers. Willingness to live and work in rural settings alongside international

- Willingness to live and work in rural settings alongside international volunteers.
- Passion for education, digital literacy, and community development.
- Adaptability to basic living conditions in rural areas and teamwork in a diverse environment.

Skills & Attitude

Responsibilities

- Strong interpersonal skills for collaborating with teachers, parents, community members, and international volunteers.
- Creativity and a willingness to learn, even without prior teaching or material design experience.
- Work 30-35 hours per week, teaching, co-designing learning materials and strategies with teachers and international volunteers, facilitating community meetings, and supporting school improvements.

• Uphold cultural sensitivity and respect for local customs while fostering positive collaboration with international volunteers.

- Complete a background check to ensure child safety, aligning with responsible volunteering practices.
- Work closely with local teachers and international volunteers to cocreate engaging learning materials and strategies, combining your local knowledge with global perspectives to enhance community education and your professional skills.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Dual Impact	YSC is designed to enhance rural education by complementing existing efforts with additional resources and innovative approaches, while equipping you with knowledge and experience for careers in education, international development, community development, or other fields through collaboration with Cambodian volunteers and leadership of short-term groups.
Safety and Support	CYA prioritizes your safety with comprehensive orientation, on-site support, and partnerships with local authorities.
Responsible Volunteering	YSC emphasizes long-term commitments and community- driven projects to ensure meaningful, ethical impact, with short-term volunteer groups carefully integrated under your leadership to maximize benefits.
Collaborative Approaches	You don't need to be an expert in teaching or leadership. You'll partner with local teachers, Cambodian volunteers, and short-term groups to design innovative learning materials, strategies, and school improvements, gaining valuable skills while contributing to community goals.

HOW TO JOIN?

STEP 1: Online Form

Fill out the online application form at <u>cyacambodia.org/ysc-apply</u> with your info, motivation, and career goals.

STEP 3: Prepare for Service

Get orientation materials, guidance on travel, and training on tasks, community work, and cultural sensitivity.

STEP 2: Atten an Interview

Shortlisted candidates will be contacted for an in-person or virtual interview to discuss their qualifications, motivations, leadership potential, and career aspirations.

STEP 3: Arrival & Begin

Travel to your assigned community and join a 2-day on-site orientation with CYA staff to begin your work and prepare for leading international volunteers.

The Use of Fees



Program Fees

To support your stay and the project's operational costs, a program fee of **\$300** per month is required. By contributing to this cost, you not only enable a meaningful volunteer experience but also ensure that the program remains sustainable and impactful for local communities.

All international volunteers receive full support before and during their service. This includes a virtual pre-departure orientation, airport pickup in Phnom Penh, in-person training, and continuous mentorship from CYA staff.

The program fee of \$300/month covers:

- Shared accommodation in rural project sites
- Three meals per day
- Airport pickup and transport to project locations
- Project materials and community tools
- On-site orientation and ongoing training
- Support from local and international coordinators
- Local transportation for doing your work
- Certificate of Completion for future academic or career use

Excluded: Volunteers are responsible for their international airfare, visa fees health insurance, and any personal expenses during their stay.

Our story began after *Mr. Sophat*, the founder, returned from Taiwan in 2010. We officially registered under the Ministry of Interior as a non-government and not-for-profit organization in 2014.
