We are excited to introduce "**Seed to Shape: Creative Approaches to Education**", an Erasmus+ Training Course organized by Viaje a la Sostenibilidad (VALS).

This five-day learning experience brings together educators, youth workers, trainers and facilitators from across Europe who are interested in exploring creative, art- and nature-based approaches within non-formal education.


During the training, participants will explore and exchange practical tools and methodologies that combine art, nature and creativity as ways to support self-expression, inclusion and participation when working with young people.

What to expect during this Training Course:

- Creative workshops based on non-formal education
- Exchange of good practices and tools among participants
- Exploration of the local impact of VALS as a source of inspiration for youth work and community-based projects

Seed to Shape is designed as a collaborative space where participants can experiment, learn from each other and build meaningful connections. By the end of the training, participants will have gained new creative tools, a deeper understanding of how art can help break social barriers and facilitate dialogue, and stronger links with other organisations and practitioners across Europe.

Target group

This training course is open to **educators, youth workers, trainers and facilitators aged 18+** who are interested in exploring creative, art- and nature-based approaches within non-formal education.

Priority will be given to young educators aged 18–26 (during the dates of the training course).

No prior artistic experience is required — just curiosity, openness and a willingness to experiment with creativity in new and inspiring ways.

Participants are expected to be open to sharing practices, learning from each other and co-creating in a collaborative and international environment. The programme includes **hands-on creative workshops and outdoor activities**, so motivation to actively take part in both is essential.

Participants must be connected to a Sending Organisation in their country of residence.

IMPORTANT: Full participation during the entire project is required in order to receive the Youthpass certificate and ensure the correct reimbursement of travel costs.

A detailed program will be presented at the beginning of the Training Course. Most of the activities will take place in IAJ's spaces and outdoors; the schedule may vary due to weather conditions.



Travel Budget

The travel budget for the round trip depends on the km distance from point A (where you begin your travel) to point B (Zaragoza, Aragón), calculated with the [official EU distance calculator](#).

Please refer to the below chart:

Selected participants will be asked to provide a TRAVEL PLAN to be confirmed by the organization.

The travel reimbursement will be processed after the end of the Training Course, upon receiving all requested documents from participants. The reimbursement of the travel costs usually takes a minimum of 3 months, so please take this into consideration before applying.

VENUE, ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

“Seed to Shape” will take place in **IAJ** - the Aragonese Youth Institute and participants will be accommodated in IAJ’s youth hostel “Baltasar Gracián”.

The accommodation is equipped with **shared rooms** with bunk beds.




FOOD
