Join us for an international youth exchange where creativity, dialogue, and diversity come together to color the world with new ideas and perspectives!

Take part in the project if you want to:

- Experience 2 weeks of intercultural communal living;
- Develop their initiative and entrepreneurial spirit;
- Improve their self-confidence;
- Learn to express their ideas effectively;
- Develop their ability to work independently;
- Develop intercultural awareness and empathy.

Step 1: Discover & Connect

During the first days, we'll focus on getting to know each other and building a strong, supportive group atmosphere. Through interactive games, creative workshops, and intercultural activities, you will:

- Share who you are and where you come from
- Discover the local culture and environment
- Explore how culture is expressed through art, fashion, colors, traditions, and daily life

Step 2: Explore & Exchange

You will work in international teams, mixing participants from different countries and backgrounds. Together, you will:

- Share your cultural roots and artistic inspirations
- Talk about important social topics that affect young people today
- Reflect on common challenges and shared values
- Express your ideas through art, discussion, and creative experimentation

Step 3: Create & Share

At the heart of the project, you will co-create a collective artistic work around the theme “Color the World.”

This could become a mural or visual artwork, an artistic installation, a performance or another creative format imagined by the group.

You will present your creation to the local community, turning your ideas into a real moment of connection and dialogue.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

You will be accommodated in various shared sleeping rooms for 4 to 8 people at Château du Créneau. Indoor bathroom facilities (showers and toilets) are available. Wi-Fi is not available on site. Food will be provided and prepared in the château kitchen by you and other participants in groups, with the support of the kitchen supervisors. Meals are in majority vegetarian; two meals per week contain meat or/and fish.

DAILY LIFE

Collective living is at the heart of the project. In addition to working on the project topic, participants will also contribute to daily tasks such as cooking, cleaning common spaces, and taking care of shared responsibilities. This organization promotes autonomy, cooperation, and a strong sense of community.

Night and weekend activities are organized collectively with the whole group.
