


PEACE

ART AS LANGUAGE

Not just a spectacle, but a true Street Art for Justice. The camp transforms squares into open-air laboratories.

Through community art, we bring a message of hope that originates in Sicily and aims to reach those still suffering from instability and poverty.

Art is not a decoration, but the tool with which participants rework the concepts of justice and civil coexistence.



THE HEART OF THE CAMP

GIRASOLI HOUSE AS A REDEMPTION PRESIDIUM

Girasoli House is a property seized from crime in Contrada Arenella, in the province of Caltanissetta, which we have transformed into a vital reception and social agriculture center.

The structure offers twelve beds and a camping area surrounded by productive almond and olive groves that are still active.

Living in this place means demonstrating with facts that the economy of legality is sustainable and capable of generating inclusive and productive beauty.



THE REVERSE INCLUSION METHOD: FROM THE SAI PROJECT TO SOCIAL PROTAGONISM

The social heart of the project lies in reversing the roles of the children at the SAI centers in Sutera, Milena, Riesi, Mazzarino, and Caltanissetta.

In this camp, the beneficiaries of the welcome become the activists who host and guide external volunteers of all ages.

This dynamic transforms those welcomed into an active resource for the local area, capable of caring for the community and those suffering in the rest of the world.





NETWORKING AND INTERNATIONAL SOLIDARITY: A BRIDGE BETWEEN SICILY AND GLOBAL EMERGENCIE

The partnership with the Una Mano per un Sorriso ODV association gives the project an international dimension that connects local redemption to major humanitarian challenges.

Throughout the ten days of the camp, participants will not be mere spectators, but will become the promoters of a fundraising campaign aimed at supporting a specific project of the organization.

This means that every artistic activity and every moment of outreach to the local community will be aimed at generating resources for those living in contexts of extreme poverty or social exclusion.

The Sound of Freedom thus transforms the management of a confiscated asset into an engine of solidarity capable of producing a real and measurable impact on the lives of many people.



ROOTS, MEMORY AND AWARENESS: ART AS A TESTIMONY OF LEGALITY

The first three days represent the fundamental moment of training and building the group.

Volunteers immerse themselves in the history of Girasoli House, deeply understanding the connection between the management of common goods, respect for rules, and freedom of expression. Their "social work" consists of transforming this historical memory into critical awareness.

This phase is essential for each participant to become a credible witness: only by understanding the roots of legality experienced in the field will volunteers be ready to take to the streets and squares, using the arts not only as entertainment, but as a powerful tool to convey a new vision of society to the community.



CREATIVE ACTION IN COMMUNITIES STREET ART AS A LANGUAGE OF FREEDOM

The camp extends beyond the confines of Girasole House to the town squares of the SAI projects in Sutera, Milena, Riesi, Mazzarino, and Caltanissetta. In this phase, the group puts into practice what they learned in the first few days: art becomes a public action to engage citizens and communicate a legality that becomes a collective "good practice."

Through music workshops, visual arts, and a final performance at sunset on the coast, volunteers and young people from SAI projects bring a message of beauty and redemption to the streets.

The goal is to transform every square into a space for meeting and reflection, demonstrating that civic engagement can be participatory, creative, and capable of speaking to everyone.






GIVING BACK TO THE COMMUNITY AND THE GRAND FINAL EVENT DIALOGUE WITH INSTITUTIONS, NETWORKING AND THE ARTISTIC EVENT

For us, the project's conclusion in San Cataldo marks the heart of our return to the region. This institutional moment will not be the usual formal conference, but a genuine open dialogue with the Mayor, local authorities, stakeholders, and especially with the local associations.

Networking is essential for us, because it shows that we're not alone, but rather that we're joining forces for the common good. After this discussion, there will be a large artistic demonstration in the square, open to all citizens.

The performances and works created during the camp will come to life in public spaces to share our achievements. It will be a celebration where we will be the protagonists of change, and it will also be the final opportunity to close our fundraising campaign for Una Mano per un Sorriso.



PARTICIPATION AND REGISTRATION FOR THE SOCIAL CAMP: A CALL FOR ALL GENERATIONS AND HOW TO JOIN US

The Sound of Freedom is an open call to the entire community, and we don't set any age limits because we firmly believe that the dialogue between the enthusiasm of young people and the experience of adults is the key to growing together.

We invite artists, dreamers, and active citizens to sign up to transform their ideas into real creative action.

The participation fee to experience the camp is 250 euros per person, but we have activated an early booking offer of 200 euros for those who book in advance.

Furthermore, this reduced fee of €200 remains fixed and always valid for all members and volunteers of the ARCI network and for members and volunteers of Una Mano per un Sorriso.





WE TRANSFORM MEMORY INTO MUSIC AND THE EARTH INTO FREEDOM
