## Global Teens for Good - International Teens Workcamp 2026

**Global Teens for Good - International Teens Workcamp** is specifically designed for teens aged 15-20. Through participating in an international volunteer workcamp, which may not guarantee constant fun but will certainly be an unforgettable experience, participants will get to witness the real-life situations in different parts of the world and reflect on how to make a positive change in the world. The programme brings together teenagers from different countries of similar age, who, with the support of VolTra facilitators, local camp leaders, and community partners, will contribute, live, and grow together, creating an unforgettable growth experience.

**Global Teens for Good** is more than just a volunteer experience; it's a journey to develop future youth leaders. Through shared living and service, participants will live, work, and learn together with their peers, forging cross-cultural friendships, and facing challenges and problem-solving in real-world situations. Over time, they will build resilience, self-confidence, and emotional maturity. As they step away from academic pressures, they will develop empathy, responsibility, and a global citizenship mindset through everyday interactions and meaningful actions. This programme empowers teens to become future leaders who can drive both local and international volunteer service, promoting collaboration and making an impact in their communities and the world.

### Programme Highlights

- Join an international workcamp with 10-25 teens volunteers across the world, sharing accommodation, meals, and daily responsibilities while practicing communication, teamwork, and intercultural living.
- A 8 - 10 day service programme grounded in community needs and sustainable development
- Fully led by experienced VolTra Facilitators and local camp leader, with comprehensive safety and duty-of-care support throughout.

# BUILDING THE WORLD THROUGH ACTION

The **Global Teens For Good** journey begins where participants are selected to become Global Teens. They will then travel to one of the four overseas volunteer projects, where they will live, serve, and learn alongside their peers from different countries.

Once confirmed, the Global Teens will attend 1 online pre-departure training workshops, as well as a provided parent briefing document to ensure guardians are fully informed about the challenges and growth their children will experience. The training will cover destination background, cultural context, community needs, and help the teens set personal goals, clarify expectations, build trust within the group, and prepare them with safety guidelines for the journey.

Each international volunteer project will be supported by at least one VolTra facilitator and a local camp leader, who will provide professional guidance, learning facilitation, and emergency support to ensure safety and learning outcomes. Global Teens will engage in volunteer service, cultural exchange, and daily reflections. Activities will primarily be conducted in English, ensuring that every participant can engage confidently.

A key focus of this project is to give Global Teens a real-world understanding of community conditions. While the programme will offer a general itinerary, adjustments may be made in response to community circumstances, project needs, and weather conditions. Global Teens will learn to maintain an open mindset, embrace cultural and lifestyle differences as part of their growth, and adapt flexibly to the various challenges and opportunities ahead. Throughout this process, under the guidance of their facilitators, participants will learn to:

- Understand the challenges faced by different countries and communities, and experience simple, local living — **“live like a local”**
- Adjust their mindset, remain flexible, and appreciate and respect cultural differences and diverse ways of life.
- Face challenges and solve problems, enhancing self-reflection, resilience, and confidence through adapting to new environments and cultural differences.
- Practice purposeful and responsible travel, contribute actively, and build meaningful community connections, becoming global citizens.
- Continuously improve personal leadership skills, integrating qualities of future global leaders into every action.

Global Teens then return home with new perspectives, motivation, and friendships, taking an important step toward becoming active global citizens.

### \*Note on Program Fee Payment:

*Please note that the programme fee includes an approximately 10% administration and bank handling fee (capped at EUR 40) payable to VolTra. The remaining balance will be remitted in full to the hosting organisation to support on-site programme delivery and materials, project site development, and local arrangements.*

*Upon acceptance, selected volunteers are required to settle the programme fee with VolTra before the pre-departure training workshop. ## APPLICATION & PROGRAMME NOTES

### 1. Programme Sponsorship & Registration

After completing registration, all applicants will proceed to the selection process. Successful candidates will receive confirmation by mid-May with payment instruction. Further details will be provided upon confirmation of registration.

### 2. Eligibility criteria

- a. Teens aged 15–20
- b. Physically and mentally fit, and able to participate in full-day outdoor activities in a group setting (including basic physical work and simple living conditions)
- c. Selection priority will be determined based on screening and overall matching.

### 3. Selection & Interview Process

After enrolment, all applicants will undergo a selection process. VolTra will assess applicants based on past experience and motivation letter, with particular focus on:

- a. Interest in cross-cultural exchange
- b. Commitment and sense of responsibility towards volunteer service;
- c. Learning attitude and teamwork skills.

Successful applicants will receive confirmation within 2 weeks after registration.

### 4. Travel & Assembly Arrangements

Action-learning content is designed by VolTra and local partner. For operational and safety reasons, all participants must assemble and dismiss with the group in the designated location. Early departure, mid-trip withdrawal is not permitted, in order to ensure smooth coordination and overall safety.

## **5. Programme Design & Arrangements**

The service content and accommodation arrangements of this international teens workcamp are specifically designed for teenagers by VolTra and its local partners. Participants will join as a team and engage in volunteer service and cultural exchange with peers of a similar age.

## **6. Departure Information & Documents**

Participants will receive detailed project information and document submission guidelines after their participation is confirmed.

## **7. Withdrawal & Cancellation**

## **8. Personal Data Collection Policy**

Provision of personal data is voluntary. However, failure to provide sufficient information may result in the Organiser being unable to process your application effectively or to make appropriate arrangements for participation in the Programme. You have the right to request access to and correction of the personal data held by us.
