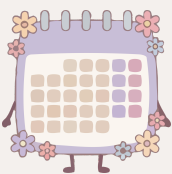

CONCORDIA

Concordia is an organisation that has existed for more than 70 years. We help people meet and work together, in France and in other countries. Originally, young Europeans created Concordia after the Second World War. They wanted to build peace and tolerance. With Concordia, you can:

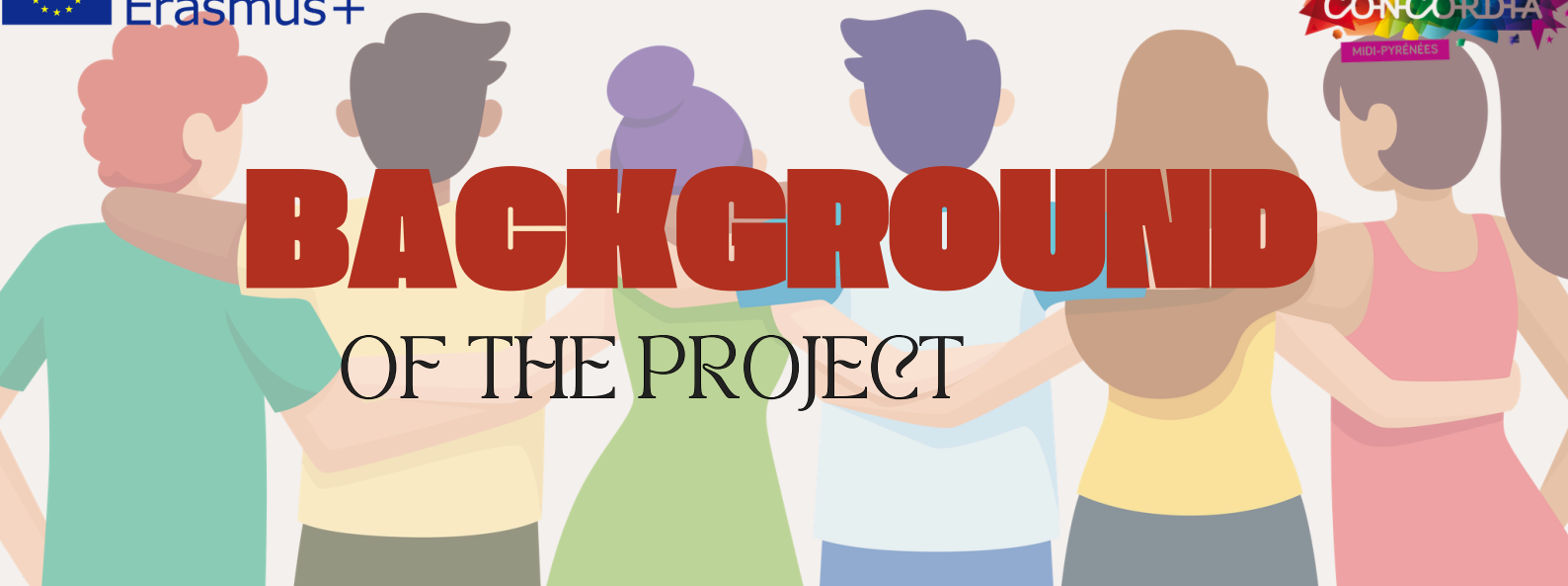
WHAT IS IT?



A Youth Exchange is a short project. Young people come from different countries. They come together for a few days. During the exchange, young people:

- Meet and live together;
- Discover important topics for society;
- Take part in workshops, role plays and outdoor activities;
- Participate in debates and exercises.

It is not a school. It is a different kind of learning, based on experience. At the end, each participant receives a Youthpass certificate to recognise what he or she has learned.



BACKGROUND

OF THE PROJECT

The Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) are global objectives. They were created by the United Nations in 2015. Their purpose is simple:

- *End poverty*
- *Protect the planet*
- *Enable everyone to live in peace and well-being by 2030*

We believe that every major change begins with small everyday actions. To change things sustainably, we must first change mindsets.



This project is about gender equality. We will reflect together on two big questions:

- *Why do inequalities between women and men still exist today?*
- *How can art help us deconstruct them and change mindsets?*



We want you to think about how to improve things in your countries. You will thus become active and engaged citizens. After working on these topics, you will create your own artistic tools to raise awareness among the people around you. You will then be able to act within your communities, encourage others to question gender stereotypes and have a real impact on society.



PROJECT' GOALS

- *Understand why it is important that everyone takes action for gender equality*
- *Learn and share the values of equality, respect for everyone's rights and the fight against gender stereotypes*
- *Meet and exchange with young people from other countries*
- *Discover what non-formal education is, meaning learning in ways other than at school, particularly through art*
- *Create your own artistic tools and organise workshops open to the public to share what you have learned*



METHODOLOGY

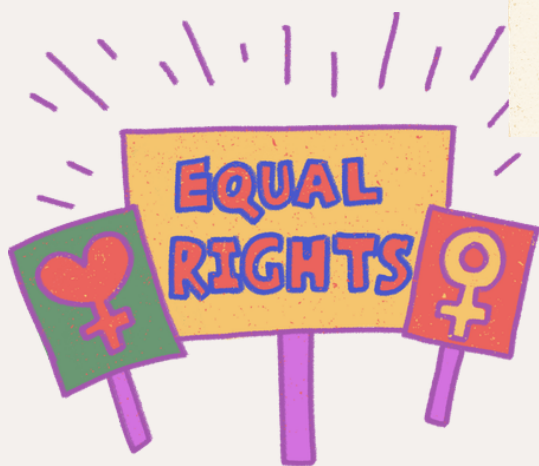
Presentation games, group cohesion games, debates, workshops, group discussions, visits to local associations active in the field of gender equality, leisure activities and visits in the Occitanie region.



The Youth Exchange programme will be based on non-formal learning. This means learning differently from school, taking into account everyone's needs, working together as equals and learning by doing.

We believe that this way of learning is the best way to allow all participants to get actively involved and express themselves freely. This method will help you discover your talents, acquire new skills and develop personally and socially.
